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MEMORANDUM FOR GUIDANCE OF APPLICANTS FOR A LICENCE TO DISCHARGE TRADE  
EFFLUENT TO A SEWER UNDER SECTION 16 OF THE  
LOCAL GOVERNMENT (WATER POLLUTION ) ACT ,1977

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1. The applicant should clearly indicate on the application form whether the discharge is an existing discharge.  
An existing discharge means a discharge which is similar in nature ,composition and temperature to and is of a similar volume and is made at a similar rate to a discharge made during any corresponding period of twelve months ending on the 1<sup>st</sup> January, 1979.
2. The completed licence application form should be accompanied by the following :-
  - (a) Plans, in triplicate, and such other particulars as are necessary to describe the premises, drainage system and any works, apparatus or plant from which the effluent or other matter is to be discharged and to identify the point of discharge to the sewer;
  - (b) Particulars of the nature, composition, anticipated temperature, volume and rate of discharge of, and the proposed method of any treatment of, the effluent or other matter and the period or periods during which the effluent or other matter is to be discharged, and
  - (b) in the case of a trade effluent, a general description of the process or activity giving rise to the discharge.
3. Where additional information is required by the Local Authority, in addition to the above, the applicant should forward such information within three months of being requested to do so.
4. The application form and particulars should be addressed to the County Secretary, Wicklow County Council, County Buildings, Wicklow.
