- (a) Motion in the names of Councillors G. Mc Loughlin, G. Jones, D. Mitchell & J. O'Sullivan (deferred from July & September meetings):  
"That Wicklow County Council confirms their plans regarding the cycle lanes from Lidl to the harbour and no progress will be made without discussion with the residents of Mountainview Park, St. Kevin's School and final approval from the councillors".
- (b) Motion in the names of Councillors G. Jones, G. McLoughlin, D. Mitchell & J. O'Sullivan (deferred from September meeting):  
"The Town Council request CIE to reinstate the 'right of way' to the beach at the side of the three trout stream in Charlesland. This right of way has been used since the existence of the Woodlands hotel as it formed part of the hotel deeds".
- (c) Motion in the names of Councillors G. Jones, G. McLoughlin, D. Mitchell & J. O'Sullivan (deferred from September meeting):  
"That the Town Council investigate installing on a pilot basis Wi fi /BB along the main shopping street (Church Road) of Greystones. This type of improvement would be in addition to what currently is being provided by shops and restaurants along this area and in line with what is being done in many progressive towns".
- (d) Motion in the names of Councillors K. Kelleher & B. Norman (deferred from September meeting):  
"That Greystones Town Council ask Wicklow County Council to improve communications between services providers so that newly surfaced roads or works are not dug up shortly after they are installed".
- (e) Motion in the names of Councillors K. Kelleher & B. Norman (deferred from September meeting):  
"That Greystones Town Council ask Wicklow County Council to improve their communications to residents when water supplies are going to be turned off".
- (f) Motion in the names of Councillors B. Norman and K. Kelleher (deferred from September meeting):  
"That Wicklow County Council examine the possibility of installing ramps at Carrig Villas as a speed restriction measure".
- (g) Motion in the names of Councillors G. Mc Loughlin, G. Jones, D. Mitchell & J. 'Sullivan:  
"That the trees overhanging on Church Lane between Oaklands and Hillside are cut back as a matter of urgency."
- (h) Motion in the names of Councillors D. Mitchell, G. Jones, G. McLoughlin & J. O'Sullivan:  
"Flooding is caused by the gullies and shores not working properly in the newer section of Oaklands. The entrance road and footpaths in the older section are full of potholes and repair and replacement is needed".
