2421 The minutes of meeting of 17th Sept., 1912, were read and confirmed.

2422 The report of meeting of General Purposes and Finance Committee of 24th Sept., 1912 was adopted on the motion of Councillor Dunne seconded by Councillor Dempsey. The Financial Statement Receipts and Expenditure Books and Treasurer's advice note were submitted and signed.

2423 The report of meeting of Public Health Committee of 24th September 1912 was adopted on the motion of Councillor Reigh seconded by Councillor Doyle.

2424 The report of meeting of Harbour Committee of 24th Sept 1912 was adapted on the motion of Councillor Archer seconded by Councillor Mackey, paragraph

714 re repairs of north and south Piers adopted subject to Engineer's approval.

2425 The report of meeting of Electric Light Committee of 24th Sept., 1912 was adopted on the motion of Councillor Traynor seconded by Councillor Reigh.

2426 Councillor Reigh proposed and Councillor Traynor seconded :-
That application be made to Commissioners of Public Works for loan of £10,000 under Housing of the Working Classes Act repayment to be made within 60 years as per sanction of Local Government Board dated 12th August 1912 No 41825/12, and letter from Commissioners of Public Works dated 13th September 1912, No 13170/12; and for loan of £1,000 under the Public Health Acts for the purpose of laying water mains, repayment to be made within 30 years, as per sanction of Local Government Board dated 26th July 1912 No 36784/12 and letter from Commissioners of Public Works dated 13th September 1912, No 13170/12."

Passed unanimously.

2424 Letter dated 25th September 1912 from Secretary Department of Agriculture and Technical Instruction stating that the Department were advised that a Chairman of a Committee appointed under Section 14 of the Agriculture

and Technical Instruction (Ireland) Act 1899, has not the right to give a second or casting vote in the event of a division at meeting of committee resulting in a tie. In the circumstances therefore no decision was actually come to by the Bray Technical Instruction Committee in reference to appointment of caretaker of Technical Schools. Referred to Technical Instruction Committee.

2428 Letter dated 24th Sept 1912 from Mr P. H. McCarthy Engineer, re Mr Mosley's tender for laying of watermain stating that the increase in price of pipes since tender was submitted was $12\frac{1}{6}$ a ton which would mean an increase of £46 over contract sum for the pipes.

Councillor O'Carroll proposed and Councillor Reigh seconded:-

That Mr Mosley be written to to know if he will accept contract at sum of £813. 18. 11

McNeill for the extra work the Council should include consent to its inclusion in Bill of Costs.

Read matter adjourned until next meeting. Mr McNeill to furnish account sent on to Messrs Hamilton and Craig.
