SUB SANITARY OFFICER'S REPORT.
2nd. June, 1931.

During the month inspected 45 premises and served two notices for Sanitary purposes which were complied with.

The usual flushing of the main-drainage and the disinfecting of the Urinals on the North and South Quays has been carried out weekly during the month, also gulley-traps.

During the month I had the Council's men engaged on Rocky Road, South Quay, Bayview Road, and Ballynerrin Road cleaning up water tables, and side dressing same, Two of the men are at present at the Waterworks with Overseer, owing to the Rain storms on the 27th. instant, several of the gulley traps got choked up by the road material which was washed into them The Roads at Kilmantin Hill, New Street, Convent Road, and Hill Side require to be resurfaced with sand or gravel, which will require about 30 loads for same.

Your Representatives appointed in connection with the Tramway had an interview with the Directors of the Great Southern Railways Company on the 28th ultimo, when it was decided for the Railway Co to appoint three Experts to go into the matter with representatives of the Council.

Your Representatives discussed the matter of the Tramway with the three Experts appointed by the Railway Co on the 1st inst, when it was decided to put the following points before the Railway Directors on Friday next:-

- 1. The Company to take over the Tramway Line as provided by Tramway Order.
- 2. The Council to indemnify the Company against Coast Erosion.
- 3. Provision to terminate agreement in the event of traffic being worked at Company's loss.
- 4. Merchants to be charged at tonnage Rate for haulage of waggons plus ld per ton for Weighing.
- 5. Crane and all Plant to be handed over to the Railway Co.
- 6. The Railway Co to compensate the Council either by tonnage or otherwise for relieving them of the responsibility in connection with Coast Erosion.
- 7. If the Railway Co agree to the above proposals the Minister of Industry's sanction to same and the consent of Earl Fitzwilliam be obtained.

SUB SANITARY OFFICER'S REPORT.
6th. July, 1931.

During the month inspected 43 premises, and served 5 notices for Sanitary purposes which were complied with.

The usual flushing of the main drainage and the disinfecting of the Gulley Traps and Urinals on the North and South Quays has been carried out weekly.

Owing to the heavy rains the road's surfacing of the Convent Road and New Street blocked up the main sewer between the Mall and Market Square, which is 130 yds. in length, and owing to the large amount of sand and stones washed into the pipes, I had to open up the Road in places, not more than every 3 yds. to have sewer cleaned, the same applies to the Stone shore at Wentworth Place to Rocky Road.

I had new water-tables laid at New Street and Convent Road, and two extra catch-pits built in Water-table at Green Hill Road, and Convent Road, had pipe laid into stone shore from catch pit which will ease the flooding at New Street and Kilmantin Hill.

I was obliged to call three members of the Public Health Committee to inspect the sewer at Abbey Street and Wentwerth Place.

I have ascertained that three premises are connected to a stone shore with a pipe laid from the stone shore to the main at Wentwerth Place. I would recommend that apipe sewer be laid for these premises as the present system is insanitary and may cause the Wentwerth Place sewer to be blocked with rubbish from stone shore.

I had three extra men employed at clearing of the sewer at Main Street, and daying new Water-tables, also painting the railings at Fitzwilliam Square.

During the month I flushed mains and repaired Fountain on Murrough, and service at Friars Hill, Council's men finished cleaning No. 1 Filtering Bed, No. 3 Bed now requires cleaning. I beg to bring to your notice a D leak that has been running on and off for the past couple of months at the premises owned by Mrs. Murray Bath Street, on a couple of accasions I stopped this leak temporary in order to avoid cutting off the water.
