Notices of Motion

- 1. Notice of motion in the names of Cllrs. J. Brady, N. Lawless, J. Snell, M. McDonald, G. O'Neill and O. O'Brien (13.04.2015) (deferred from meeting of the 11th May, 8th June, 6th July, 7th September, 5th October, 2nd November and 7th December 2015)**

'This Council calls on the Tanaiste and Minister for Social Protection to abandon the plan to phase out lone parents payments once children reach seven years of age. Some 11,000 lone parent families have already been affected by these gradual reductions. Further reductions will impact on 32,000 lone parent families in July this year, pushing families further into poverty. It is noted that the Tanaiste had previously make commitments that there would be affordable and accessible childcare before the reduction payments and that to date Ireland has one of the highest childcare costs in the OECD meaning more families will be pushed into poverty when there has already been a notable rise in child poverty over the last five years'

- 2. Notice of motion in the name of Cllr. S. Matthews (13.05.2015) (deferred from meeting of the 6th July, 7th September, 5th October, 2nd November and 7th December 2015)**

"Use of CEM III cement in Local Authority Procurement Projects - Where Wicklow County Council procures Local Authority construction projects, CEM III/A cement will be specified in the tendering process following Green Public Procurement Directives (2004/17/EC and 2004/18/EC) & Green Procurement Government Policy. This local authority initiative will set an example by increasing the sustainability of our development practices and will have a positive effect on climate change by contributing reductions with regards to our national CO2 emission targets".

“That this Council would adopt this resolution in support of Cork City Council in its actions against the proposed merger of Cork City and County Councils, and further supports its challenge to the Local Government Reform programme, which undermines the European principle of subsidiarity”. We also direct the meetings administrator to inform the Minister for the Environment and Local Government and the Secretary General of the same Department of the passing of this motion by this Council.
- 6. Notice of motion in the names of Cllrs. C. Fox, J. Ruttle and D. Nolan (07.09.2015)(deferred from meeting of the 2nd November and 7th December 2015)**
“That the Housing section furnish the elected members with details and protocol in relation to the control of horses. In particular:
a) *Details of scanning chipped horses*
b) *Details of methods used to establish ownership of impounded horses*
c) *Details of the breakdown of costings and receipts associated with the impounding of horses process.”*

Wicklow residents pay their LPT on the basis it is for the provision of local services and as such the removal of 20% from Wicklow County Council has a significant impact on Wicklow’s Budget.”
