Notices of Motion

1. Notice of motion in the name of Cllr. S. Bourke (6th March 2017).

"In light of the new proposals to give greater rights to cyclists on our public roads, that Wicklow County Council reviews its policy in relation to 'white-lining' of public roads with cycle lanes, to improve motorist awareness of the rights of cyclists".

2. Notice of motion in the name of Cllr Joe Behan, Cllr Tom Fortune and Cllr Steven Matthews (1st June 2017)

'Members of Wicklow County Council are calling on the Minister for Children and Youth Affairs Katherine Zappone to increase investment in Early Childhood Care and Education to ensure that children have access to quality, sustainable and affordable childcare with decent pay and conditions for professionals in the sector.

The Council recognises that Early Years Educators are hugely dedicated professionals who care for and educate children during the most crucial years of their development. However the Irish government lags behind other European countries in terms of how much we invest in Early Years Education. As a result, many qualified professionals are struggling to make ends meet and providers are struggling to stay open.

We call on Minister Zappone to put children first and invest in quality childcare and Early Years Education'
