Cllr. J. Behan proposed an amendment 'to *defer putting the plan on public display on the basis of receiving clarification on two items; statement by the Minister for the OPW that he is not in favour of building on floodplains and that anyone who builds on a flood plain will be able to get insurance for their property.*' The proposal was seconded by Cllr. O Connor. Cllr. O O Brien proposed an amendment to Cllr. Behan's proposal that 'the Plan, with the exception of this particular aspect goes out on public display.' Cllr P. Fitzgerald then proposed that the Council go ahead with the process of public display which was seconded by Cllr. C. Fox.

Following a discussion on the matter the proposal put forward by Cllr. J. Behan, seconded by Cllr. M. O Connor: 'that this Council defers a decision to put the Bray Municipal District Plan on Public display until clarification has been received by the Minister for Public Works and the Irish Insurance Authorities on the question of insurance of buildings to be built in the Dargle River Flood plain' was put to a vote and following a roll call was defeated 8 votes for, 19 against and 5 not present viz:-
