Notice of motion in the name of Cllr. Rory O'Connor (11th June, 2019).

"The members of Wicklow County Council hereby resolve to introduce a county wide ban on the sale, distribution and burning of smoky coal in the absence of action from the Government on the matter. The members of Wicklow County Council note that seriously damaging effects on health and the environment from the continued burning of smoky fuels and express disappointment that the announcement in October, 2018 by then Minister, Alan Kelly, of the Government's intention to proceed with a nationwide ban has not yet been implemented. The council further notes the subsequent commitment from the Minister Denis Naughton to have the ban introdeuced by 2019. A total 10,344 people over the age of 18 suffer with asthma within Wicklow.

Calls on the Executive of the Council to:

- introduce and enforce a County wide ban on the sale and use of smoky fuels to take effect on November, 2019;
- provide an information campaign to consumers in Wicklow on the dangers of smoky coal;
- · publicly notify all retailers and wholesalers about the decision of the county wide ban on the sale

and use of smoky fuels;

- update the members of Wicklow County Council monthly on the number of inspections carried out pursuant to the decision;
- formally write to the Minister for Communications, Climate Action and Envrionment and to An
 Taoiseach, Leo Varadkar, informing him of the decision and urging them to introduce the nationwide
 ban without delay, as committed to by this Government and previous Ministers;
- formally write to each member of the Oireachtas in Wicklow urging them to pursue the matter with the Minister and with the Government and to update the members of the Council on progress in this matter;
- seek a formal meeting with Wicklow TD and Minister for Health, Simon Harris, to allow members discuss the need for his support for this measure and to ensure that the health implications are understood".
