1. Notice of motion in the name of CIIr.Jennifer Whitmore (31st October, 2018)

"That Wicklow County Council install a network of water fountains and bottle-refill stations across each Municipal District to help reduce the use of single use packaging, such as plaster water bottles".

"That this Council reognise the landmark decision in the European Parliment when MEP's voted overwhelmingly in favour of an EU-wide ban on single use plastics in all County Council buildings in County Wicklow and at any council funded functions, within 3 months of passing of motion?".
