1. Notice of motion in the name of Cllrs. S. Bourke and I. Winters (29.07.2015) (deferred from meeting of the 7<sup>th</sup> September, 5<sup>th</sup> October, 2<sup>nd</sup> November and 7<sup>th</sup> December 2015)

"That Wicklow County Council make arrangements to install signage for Barndarrig from the new M11 motorway"

2. Notice of motion in the names of the Arklow Municipal District Members: Cllrs. P. Fitzgerald, P. Kennedy, T. Annesley, S. Bourke, M. Murphy and M. McDonald (04.08.2015). (deferred from meeting of the 7<sup>th</sup> September, 5<sup>th</sup> October, 2<sup>nd</sup> November and 7<sup>th</sup> December 2015)

"The Members of Arklow Municipal District request the T/Chief Executive Officer to retain the premises currently being used for the Arklow Library on St. Mary's Road in the ownership of Wicklow County Council, and following the opening of the new Library that this building be then used to house a Museum for Arklow town" 3.
