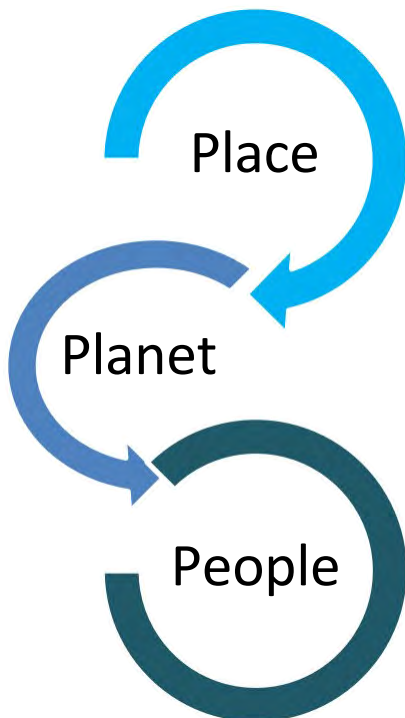
The finished plan will be available in December 2024.

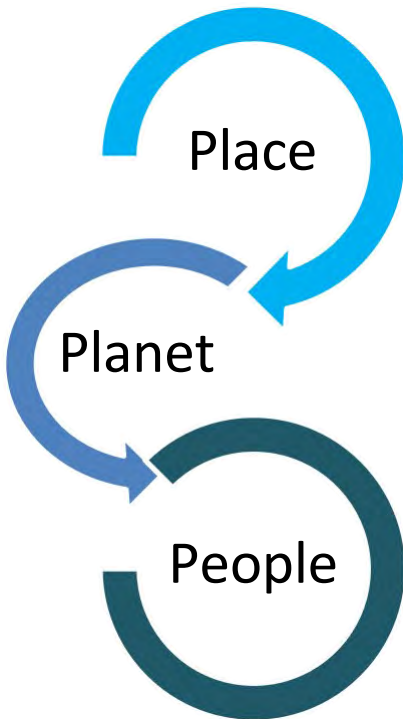
