

# Arklow Town and Environs Development Plan 2011 - 2017

Notice is hereby given under Section 12 (12) of the Planning and Development Act 2000 (as amended) that Wicklow County Council and Arklow Town Council made a new Arklow Town and Environs Development Plan on Monday the 7th of March 2011 and 9th March 2011 respectively. This plan will have effect from Tuesday 5th April 2011

The new Town and Environs Development Plan will be available for inspection at the following locations from Tuesday 5th April 2011.

- Planning Department, Wicklow County Council, Station Road, Wicklow Town
- Arklow Town Council, Avoca River House, North Quay, Arklow

This plan is accompanied by a statement ('SEA Statement') summarising:

- (a) how environmental considerations have been integrated into the plan,
- (b) how
  - the environmental report prepared pursuant to Article 13C of the Planning and Development (SEA) Regulations 2004,
  - submissions and observations made to the planning authority in response to a notice under Section 12(1) or (7) of the Act, and
  - any consultations under Article 13F of the Planning and Development (SEA) Regulations 2004,

have been taken into account during the preparation of the plan,

- (c) the reasons for choosing the plan, as adopted, in the light of the other reasonable alternatives dealt with, and
- (d) the measures decided upon to monitor, in accordance with article 13J of the Planning and Development (SEA) Regulations 2004, the significant environmental effects of implementation of the plan.
