

## Wicklow County Development Plan 2010-2016 Variation No. 1(ii) – Donard Settlement Plan

Notice is hereby given that the elected members of Wicklow County Council, at their meeting of 5<sup>th</sup> of September 2011, proposed a 'material alteration' to proposed Variation No.1 (ii) to the Wicklow County Development Plan 2010-2016 (Donard Settlement Plan), in accordance with Section 13 of the Planning and Development Act 2000 (as amended).

The accordance with Section 13 (6) (aa), the Planning Authority has determined (with regard to the provisions of the Planning and Development (SEA) Regulations 2004), that neither a Strategic Environmental Assessment nor an Appropriate Assessment (AA) under the EU Habitats Directive (92/43/EEC) is required.

The proposed material alteration provides for:

- a) The extension of the Donard settlement boundary by approximately 1.9ha and the zoning of this land as 'Tertiary Lands'
- b) The addition of a new objective 'DON 40' relating to these lands.

A copy of the proposed 'material alteration' and the determination of the Planning Authority with regard to SEA / AA will be available for public inspection during normal opening hours from 19<sup>th</sup> September to the 14<sup>th</sup> October 2011 at the following locations:
