### Avoca Settlement Plan

The Department notes that the waste water treatment plant is '*currently overloaded and has no extra capacity*' with only primary treatment taking place prior to discharge into the Avoca river which is of particular concern to the Department.

The Department's circular letter 'Waste Water Discharge (Authorisation) Regulations SI No 684 of 2007' dated 16 July 2009 (PD 7/09) indicates that where a plant will not be immediately compliant, planning authorities should avoid giving permission to applications which create significant additional loadings, or they should consider granting permission where upgraded facilities would be in place 'within a reasonable timescale' such that the necessary requirements are met.

Given the current unacceptable situation at Avoca, the Department considers that the variation should indicate clearly that no new development will be permitted which would add to the waste water load until the waste water disposal facility has been upgraded and meets license requirements under the Waste Water Discharge Regulations (SI No 684 of 2007).

Please note that this letter supersedes our previous letter issued today.

The OPW wishes to make the following comments on the above.

1. The Office of Public Works welcomes that a Strategic Flood Risk Assessment (SFRA) has been carried out as part of the Proposed Variation No. 1(ii) to the Wicklow County Development Plan 2010-2016 – Donard Settlement Plan, and that this variation has followed the 'Planning System and Flood Risk Management Guidelines for Local Authorities.

2. We welcome the inclusion of the following objectives in the Proposed Variation:

DON13 It is an objective of the Council to restrict the types of development permitted in Flood Zone A and Flood Zone B to the uses that are 'appropriate' to each flood zone, as set out in Table 3.2 of the Guidelines for Flood Risk Management (DoEHLG, 2009). The planning authority may consider proposals for development that may be vulnerable to flooding, and that would generally be inappropriate as set out in Table 3.2 of the Guidelines, subject to all of the following criteria being satisfied:

• The planning authority is satisfied that all of the criteria set out in the justification test as it applies to development management (Box 5.1 of the Guidelines) are complied with.

• The development of lands for the particular use is required to achieve the proper planning and sustainable development of the settlement, and complies with at least one of the following:

- i. The development is located within the 'primary lands' and is essential for the achievement of the 'zoning objectives' or for the achievement of a specific objective for these lands.
- ii. The development comprises previously developed and/or under-utilised lands/sites,
- iii. There are no suitable alternative lands for the particular use, in areas at lower risk of flooding.

DON34 To preserve the use of the Donard GAA grounds (identified as DON 34 on the plan map) as recreational and active open space use.

3. We also welcome that the objectives and policies of 'Section 12.6: Flooding' of the Wicklow County Development Plan 2010-2016 F1 through to F9 shall also apply:

4. We would recommend that the SFRA should be updated in the future, as more flood risk information becomes available for the area. The Preliminary Flood Risk Assessment (PFRA) Mapping will be available before the end of this year, and the Catchment Flood Risk Assessment Mapping (CFRAM) will be available before the end of 2013. These flood risk mapping datasets will allow Flood Zones A and B for the area to be further refined, and this may affect the proposed zoning in the plan.

This is a submission by Ted Flynn, Donard, the owner of all the secondary lands around "DON 25" save the Garda Station to the east and Donard Glen Day Care Centre to the west.

As the planning authority will know from outline application (Reg. Ref. No. 10/2909) Ted Flynn proposes to develop this property for housing at approx. 10 units per hectare for which the Council decided recently to grant outline permission for a phase one of 9 houses. The Council will be aware our client's intention is to develop to a cul de sac pattern to preclude through traffic in the interest of residential amenity and traffic safety. This is also clear from the Section 247 Consultation process and from the Planning Officer's Report of November 25<sup>th</sup> 2010 at Item No. 3 (Design/Layout) of which the planner states "The plans submitted provide for a single access route off the public road. The access route forms a cul de sac with a central open space area."

Accordingly, our client is strongly opposed to objective "DON 25" which will have the materially adverse planning effect of GAA and Caravan traffic invading the peace and quiet of our client's proposed village scale development. As well as this inessential through traffic eroding residential amenity, DON 25, will be an open invitation for GAA patrons to park on Ted Flynn's village estate roads.

DON 25 is unnecessary and is in direct conflict with what Ted Flynn proposes and with the proper planning and sustainable development of a small and intimate village housing type residential enclave that prior to the publication of the Donard Settlement Plan appeared to be what the planning authority itself wished for on this property.




