

Wicklow County Development Plan 2010-2016

Draft 'Greystones-Delgany & Kilcoole Local Area Plan (LAP) 2013-2019'

(linked to Proposed Variation No. 3 to the Wicklow County Development Plan 2010-2016)

Notice is hereby given pursuant to Section 20 of the Planning and Development Act 2000 (as amended) that Wicklow County Council, being the planning authority for the area, intends to prepare a Local Area Plan for the area of Greystones-Delgany and Kilcoole. This plan will, when adopted, replace the existing 'Greystones-Delgany LAP 2006' and the 'Kilcoole LAP 2008'.

The draft 'Greystones-Delgany and Kilcoole LAP 2013-2019' will consist of a written statement indicating the objectives in detail as may be required by the planning authority for the proper planning and sustainable development of the area, maps and appendices.

The draft LAP is accompanied by an Environmental Report outlining the likely significant effects on the environment of implementing the draft LAP. This report has been prepared in accordance with the Planning and Development [Strategic Environmental Assessment] Regulations 2004 (as amended). The draft LAP is also accompanied by a Habitats (Appropriate) Assessment Stage 1 Report (screening), pursuant to Article 6[3] of the Habitats Directive 92/43/EEC.

The 'Draft Greystones-Delgany and Kilcoole LAP 2013-2019' and associated documents will be on display at the following locations from **Wednesday 19th December 2012 to Friday 8th February 2013** inclusive:

All written submissions or observations will be duly considered by the planning authority. Please note that submissions will be available for public viewing.
