Proposed Additions to and Deletions from the Record of Protected Structures (RPS)

(linked to draft 'Greystones-Delgany and Kilcoole Local Area Plan 2013-2019')

In accordance with Section 55 of the Planning and Development Act 2000 (as amended), the planning authority proposes to make additions to and deletions from the Record of Protected Structures (RPS). All of the proposed additions and deletions are located within the proposed boundaries of the draft 'Greystones – Delgany and Kilcoole Local Area Plan 2013-2019'.
