

Proposed Variation No. 2(i) – Kilmacanogue Settlement Plan

Notice is hereby given that the elected members of Wicklow County Council, at their meeting of 3rd October 2011, proposed 3 no. ‘material alterations’ to the proposed Variation No.2 (i) to the Wicklow County Development Plan 2010-2016 (Kilmacanogue Settlement Plan), in accordance with Section 13 of the Planning and Development Act 2000 (as amended).

The accordance with Section 13 (6) (aa), the Planning Authority has determined (with regard to the provisions of the Planning and Development (SEA) Regulations 2004), that neither a Strategic Environmental Assessment nor an Appropriate Assessment (AA) under the EU Habitats Directive (92/43/EEC) is required.

A copy of the proposed ‘material alterations’ and the determination of the Planning Authority with regard to SEA / AA will be available for public inspection during normal opening hours from 24th October to the 21st November 2011 at the following locations:
