

# **Proposed Variations to the Wicklow County Development Plan 2010-2016 Laragh - Glendalough**

Notice is hereby given pursuant to Section 13(2) of the Planning and Development Act 2000 (as amended) that Wicklow County Council is considering making a variation (Variation No. 2) to the Wicklow County Development Plan 2010-2016 as follows:

## **Proposed Variation No. 2(ii) – Laragh-Glendalough Settlement and Tourism Plan**

Adoption into the County Development Plan 2010-2016 of the Laragh-Glendalough Settlement and Tourism Plan 2011

Reason: A development plan is required in order to

- (a) Establish a framework for the planned, coordinated and sustainable development of Laragh-Glendalough and the management of Tourism in the area.

This plan will consist of a written statement and maps.

A copy of the proposed variation and accompanying SEA/HDA documentation (including the decision of the Planning Authority regarding the reasons for not requiring an Environmental Assessment / Appropriate Assessment of the proposed variation) will be available for inspection (and purchase) during normal opening hours within the period from Monday 4th July to the 2nd of August 2011 at the following locations:

- Planning Department, Wicklow County Council, Station Road, Wicklow Town
- Bray Town Council Offices
- Libraries in Bray-Ballywaltrim Branch Library, Boghall Road and Bray Public Library, Eglinton Road, and the Mobile library
- Brockagh Centre, Laragh

Written submissions (including e-mail) with respect to the future development of either town may be made during the period 4th July 2011 to 2nd August 2011 (both dates inclusive) up to 5pm and any valid submissions so made will be taken into consideration by the Council before the making of the variation.

Submissions should clearly indicate the plan to which it relates to and be addressed for the attention of Director of Services, Planning & Development, Wicklow County Council, County Buildings, Wicklow Town or they may be emailed to [planreview@wicklowcoco.ie](mailto:planreview@wicklowcoco.ie). All submissions should state the name(s) and address (es) of the person, group or public body from whom same is received.
