Notice is hereby given pursuant to Part II, Section 20 of the Local Government (Planning & Development) Act 2000 (as amended) that Wicklow County Council being the Planning Authority for County Wicklow has made a Local Area Plan for Rathdrum at the Council meeting on the 8<sup>th</sup> May 2017.

The Local Area Plan (LAP) in accordance with Section 20 (4a) will come into effect on the 4<sup>th</sup> of June and consists of a written statement indicating the objectives in detail as may be required by the Planning Authority for the proper planning and sustainable development of the area, maps and appendices.

The adopted Plan is accompanied by a Strategic Environmental Assessment Screening Report, prepared in accordance with the Planning & Development [Strategic Environmental Assessment] Regulations 2004 (as amended). The adopted Plan is also accompanied by an Appropriate Assessment Screening Report pursuant to Article 6[3] of the Habitats Directive 92/43/EEC. It has been determined that a Stage 2 appropriate assessment is not required.
