I propose that the route from the Glenealy Church to the Carrick Mountain and the public amenity area there needs to be registered as a Right of Way Part of this route is the the L—10963 known as Chapel Lane (or Ballymanus Lane): the full extent of the public road is disputed however the entire route has been used by many generations to reach Carrick Mountain.
