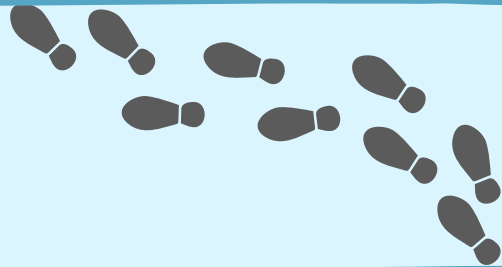


# BELLEVUE HILL FOOTPATH

## What is proposed?

- In 2021 funding was received by Wicklow County Council under the Active Travel Scheme to construct a footpath and associated public lighting along the L-1030 @ Bellevue Hill, Greystones. The extents of that scheme are highlighted in red on the image above.
- The new scheme being proposed in 2022 aims to construct a new 250m long footpath along the route highlighted in blue below, which will connect the footpath constructed in 2021 with existing footpath infrastructure located on the Delgany Village side.



## Active Travel in Wicklow

- Promote awareness and uptake of travelling with a purpose, using your own energy by means of walking or cycling.
- Improve transport options for those choosing alternatives to the car.

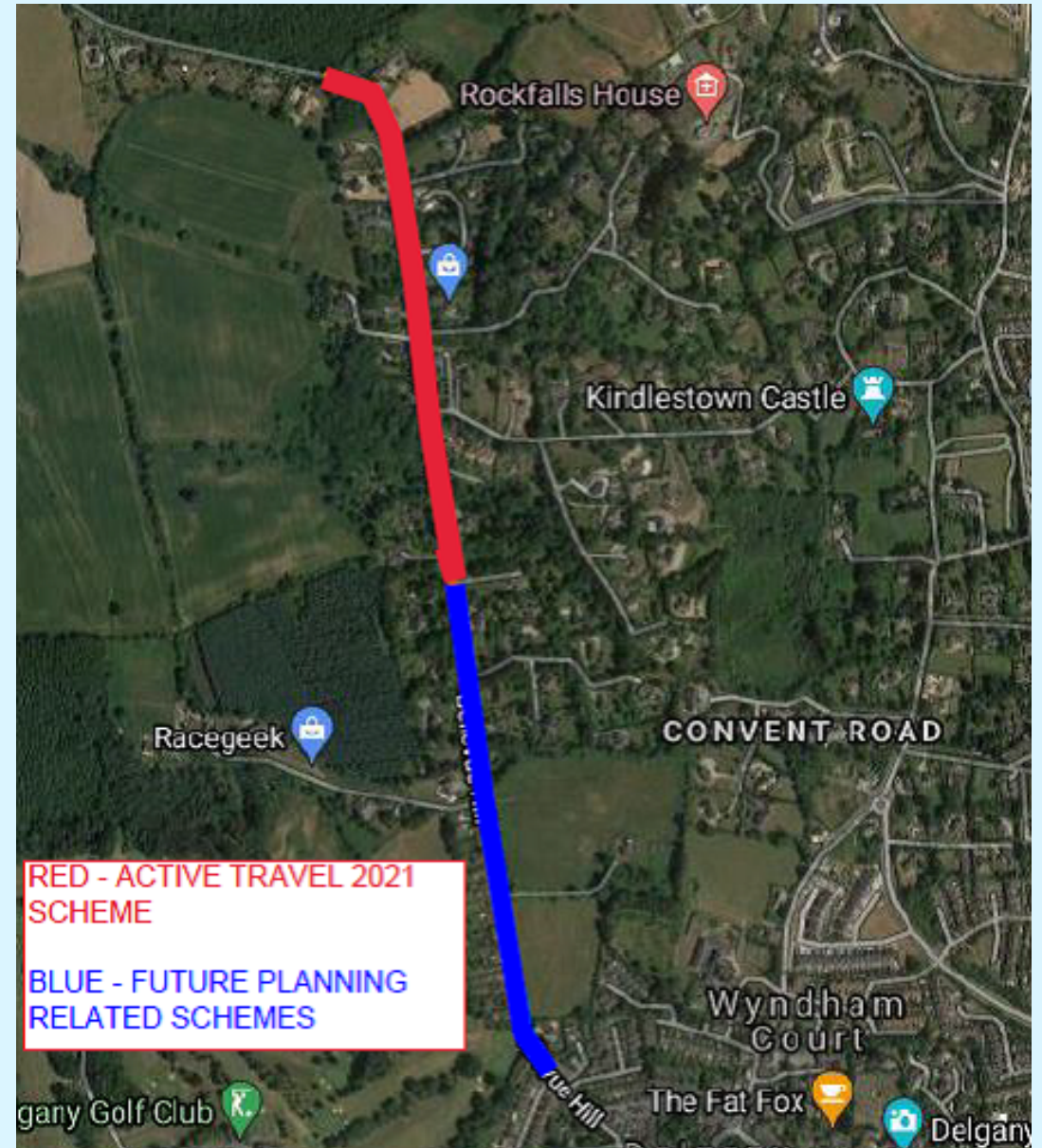


Figure 1 - Project Location Map
