
KILCOOLE ROAD PEDESTRIAN & CYCLE IMPROVEMENTS

What is proposed?

This scheme proposes to upgrade the pedestrian and cycle facilities along the R-761 in Greystones, Co. Wicklow by installing 500m of cycle track and a widened footpath between the new Archers Wood housing development and the existing cycle and pedestrian facilities located on the Farrinkelly ring road (R-774). The new infrastructure will be installed in the existing grassed verge.

- Promote awareness and uptake of travelling with a purpose, using your own energy by means of walking or cycling.

Why are these works required?

- This scheme will improve linkages between the Farninkelly area and the Knockroe roundabout in particular, to designate lands for new housing in this area, subject to substantial improvement to access routes, for pedestrians and cyclists.
- The scheme will provide an improved level of service for cyclists and pedestrians.
- The scheme will provide improved and safer linkages to public transport, schools and community services.
- The scheme will encourage a modal shift away from motorised forms of transport and will promote and encourage healthy living, wellness and wellness through walking and cycling.




Figure 1 - Project Location Map
