Members were advised that the Forum sub group have issued a package to the ESB in respect of the Burgage Castle preservation project.

### AOB

District administrator Garvan Hickey proposed that the CCTV project for the town be advanced by the Baltinglass Municipal District and this was agreed by the Town Team. Garvan Hickey advised that advertisements would shortly be placed in the Wicklow People and Wicklow Times and the subcommittee for CCTV was confirmed as John Horan, Michael Sargent, Jason Mulhall, Detective Sargent Dermot Tracey and Garvan Hickey.
