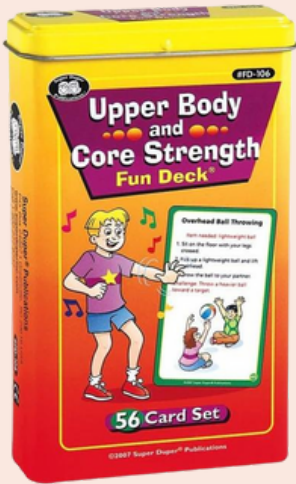

Gross Motor Skills



Fun Deck: Upper Body and Core Strength

This deck helps to teach controlled use and stability of a child's trunk, shoulders, elbows, wrists, hands, and fingers. These skills build an important foundation to help children complete everyday tasks successfully.

Age: 4+

Movin' Sit Cushion Adult

This cushion helps to satisfy the sensory need for movement. The wedge shape helps balance, encourages proper sitting and correct posture. Very beneficial for those with poor body awareness and low muscle tone.

Age: 8+, max weight 120kgs



Movin' Sit Cushion Junior

This cushion helps to satisfy the sensory need for movement. The wedge shape helps balance, encourages proper sitting and correct posture. Very beneficial for those with poor body awareness and low muscle tone.

Age: 3+, max weight 45kgs





Peanut Physio Roll 40cm, Red

Physio rolls are easier to use than traditional gym balls as most of the movement is limited to forward and back, providing greater stability than a round ball.

Use under adult supervision. Max weight 120kg.

Peanut Physio Roll 55cm, Green

Physio rolls are easier to use than traditional gym balls as most of the movement is limited to forward and back, providing greater stability than a round ball.

Use under adult supervision. Max weight 120kg.



Putt Putt Balance Board

A balance board designed for one person. Improves strength and flexibility in ankle joints and develops a sense of balance and co-ordination. The anti-slip design on the bottom of the board ensures the safety of the user.

Age: 3 - 7 , use under adult supervision



Rody

The saddle shape makes it easy to straddle, sit on or roll over. Designed to improve balance, gross motor skills and core strength, can also be beneficial for those with attention or movement needs.

Age: 3+, max 45kg, use under adult supervision.

Rody Max

Rody Max, which is dedicated to older children, is the large version of the Rody horse. It is a dynamic toy and a valuable psycho-motor tool, which helps developing balance, coordination and movement skills.

Age: 5+, max 90kg, use under adult supervision.



Seesaw

Classic play equipment in a unique new design.

Pliable synthetic rubber domes on the underside of the seesaw provide a softer, more dynamic movement.

Age: 2+, max weight 75kg, use under adult supervision

Therapy Balancing Top

Balance tops made of high-quality molded plastic, produced in blow-technique, tread surface or contured surface for secure hold. Lots of knobs are arranged uniformly on the surface, thus enhance comfortable stimulance and intensive and sensoric impulsion.

Max 120kg, **use under adult supervision.**

Alphabet Fishing

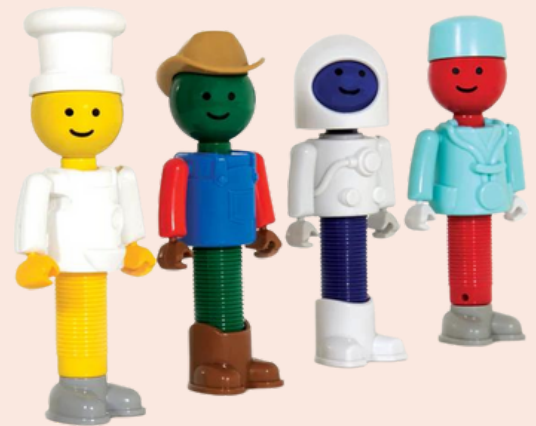

Chunky Peggy

The different shapes and colours, together with the rattle peg included are designed to develop and strengthen visual perception skills, eye hand coordination and fine motor skills, including the pincer grasp (thumb and index finger) so crucial to fine motor development and control.
