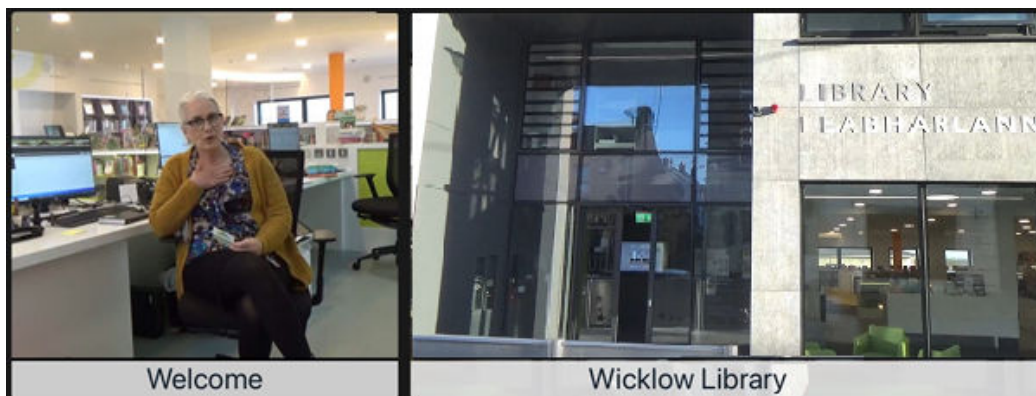


**We are looking forward to welcoming you to our library**

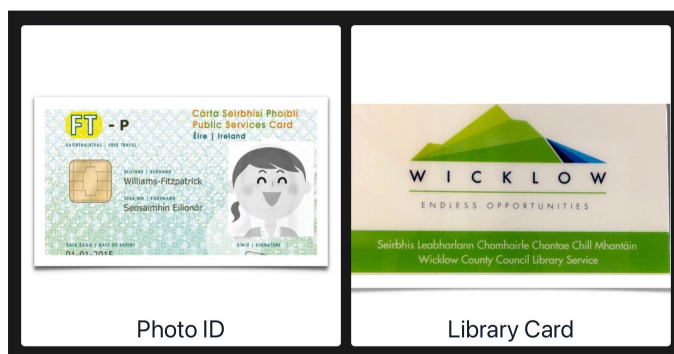


## **To help you plan your first visit, here are a few things you need to know: What should I bring?**

For Adults: Please bring some photo ID and proof of your address, such as a bill or official letter.

For Kids: bring an adult with a library card (if the adult needs to join too, see above)

You can also register to join online before you arrive. Go to this link: <https://lgma.iii.com/selfreg> and complete the details. When you come to the library bring the account number and we will give you your library card.



You can borrow on your first visit so be sure to bring your **library bag** to bring your books home.

### **What else do I need to know?**

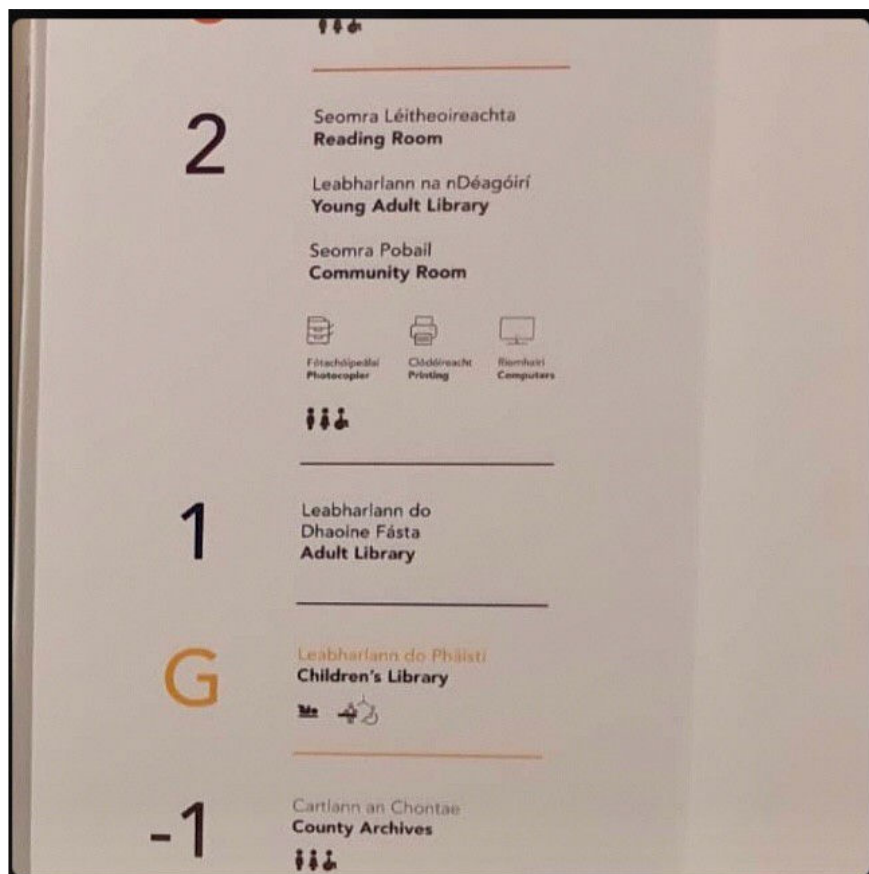
- You can borrow up to 12 items, including books
- You can keep your borrowed books for up to three weeks and can renew them twice if no one else is waiting for them. You can renew online using your library card or bring them in.

We have a great selection of Board books, Story books and early readers.

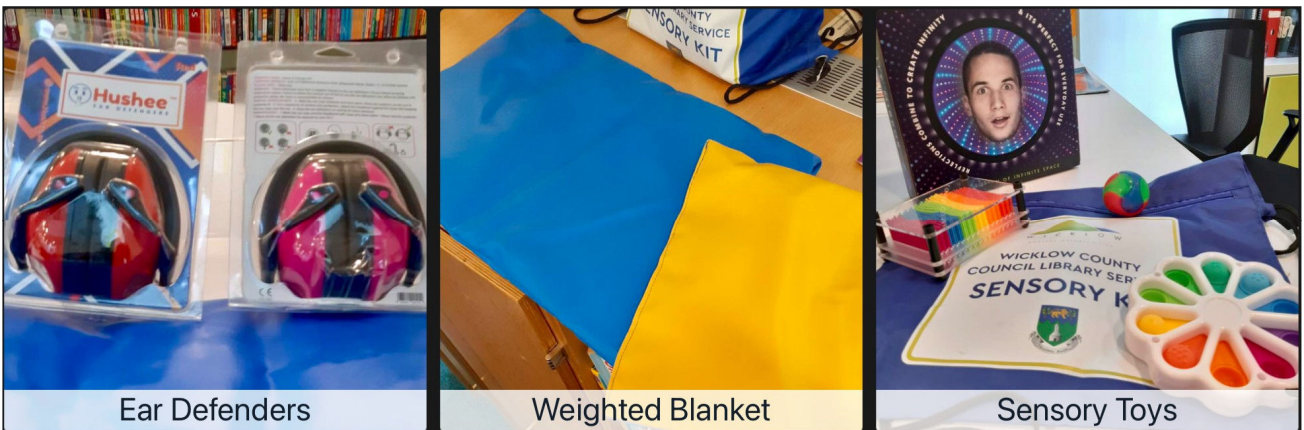

## Adult Non-fiction and Reference

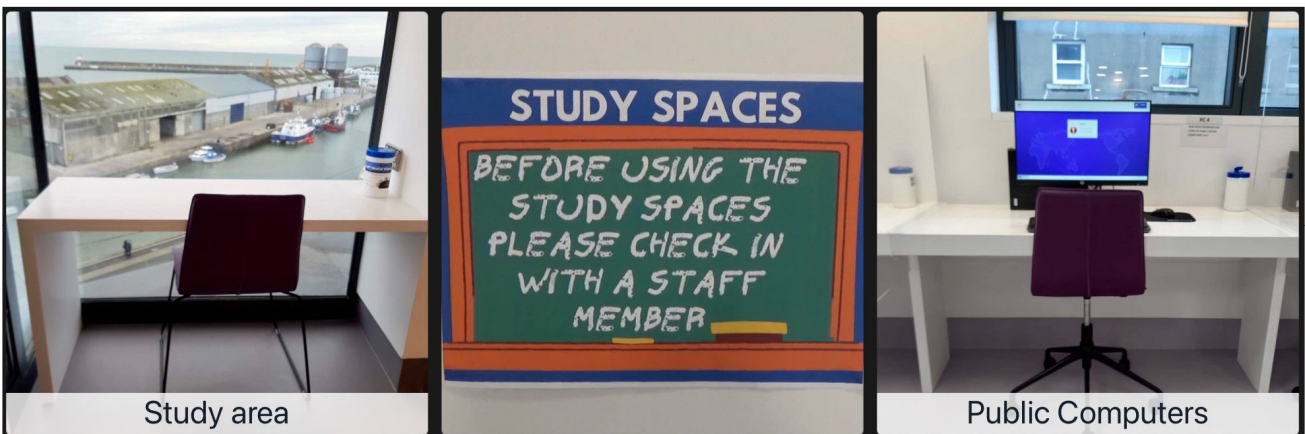

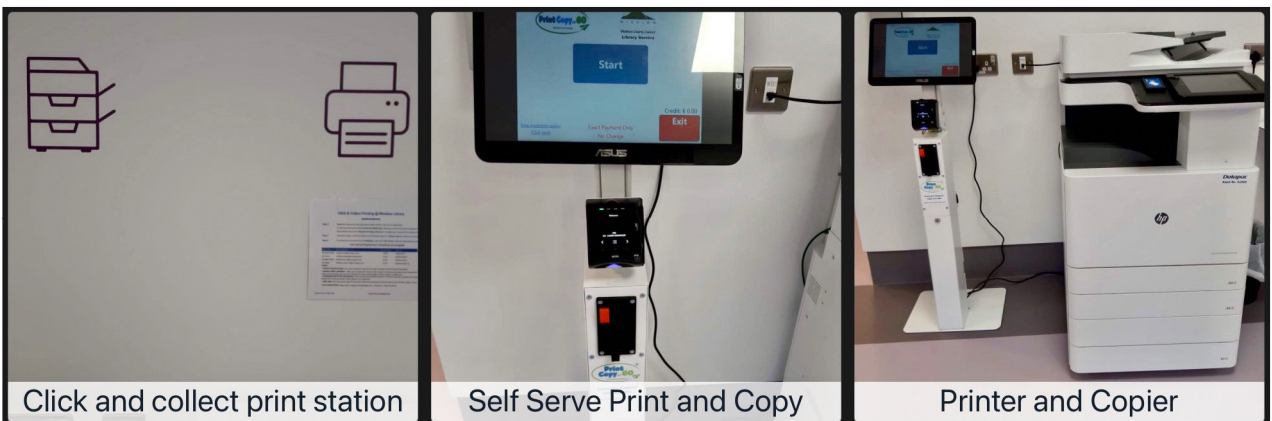
On the next floor up you will find our Young Adult Library.
