

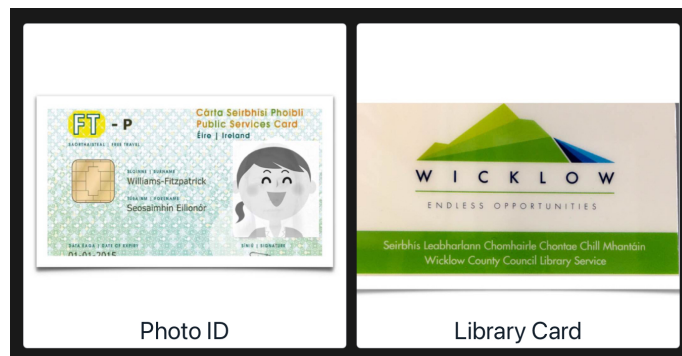
**We are really looking forward to welcoming you to our library here in Arklow**



**To help you plan your first visit, here are a few things you need to know:**

**What should I bring?**

For Adults: Please bring some photo ID and proof of your address, such as a bill or official letter.  
For children, bring an adult with a library card or their ID + proof of address (if the adult needs to join to, see above)



You can also register to join online before you arrive. Go to this link: <https://lgma.iii.com/selfreg> and complete the details. When you come to the library bring the account number and your ID + proof of address and we will give you your library card.

You can borrow on your first visit, so be sure to bring a bag to bring your books home.

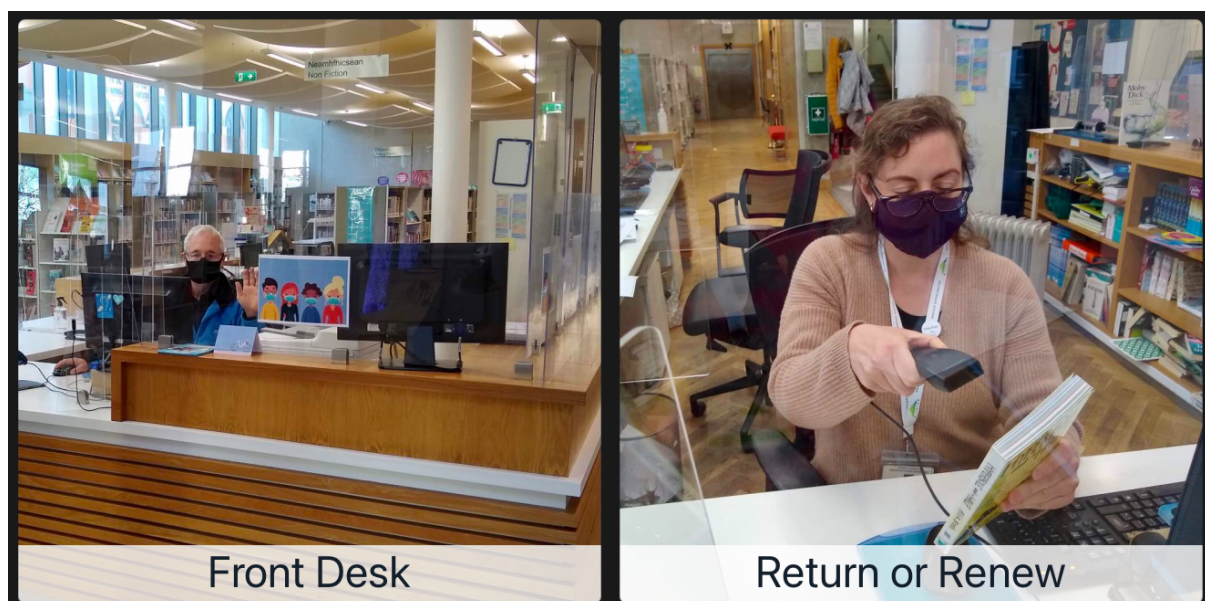
**What else do I need to know?**

- You can borrow up to 12 items.
- You can keep your borrowed books for up to three weeks and can renew them if no one else is waiting for them

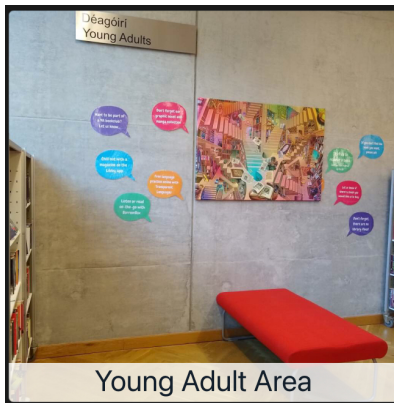

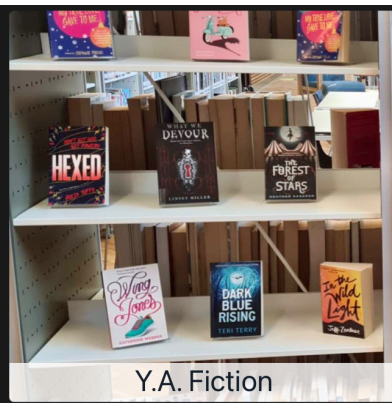

## Adult Fiction and New books,



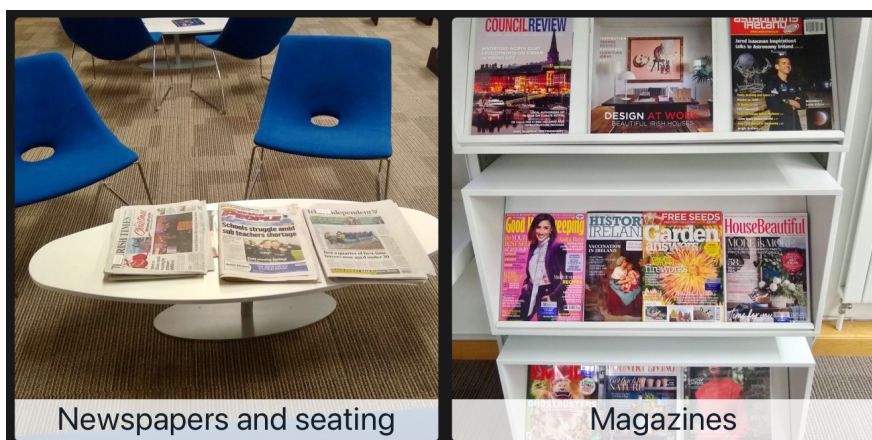
Our fiction section is sorted by author from A to Z. If there is a particular title or author which you would like but cannot find, be sure to come back to the desk and ask.

Non fiction books are arranged by subject. There is a poster to help you find what you are looking for. If you need help please ask a member of staff.

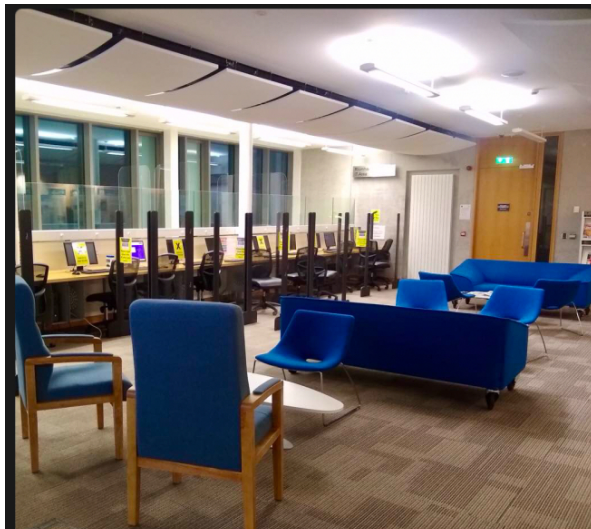

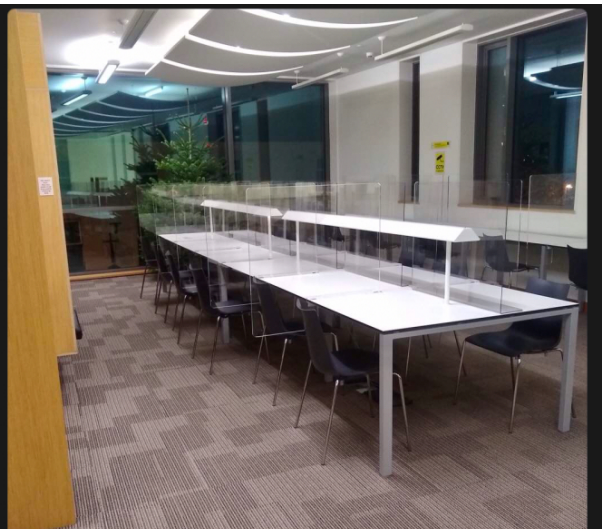
We also have a section here where you are welcome to sit down and flick through an actual newspaper or magazine. (Rather than an online one)

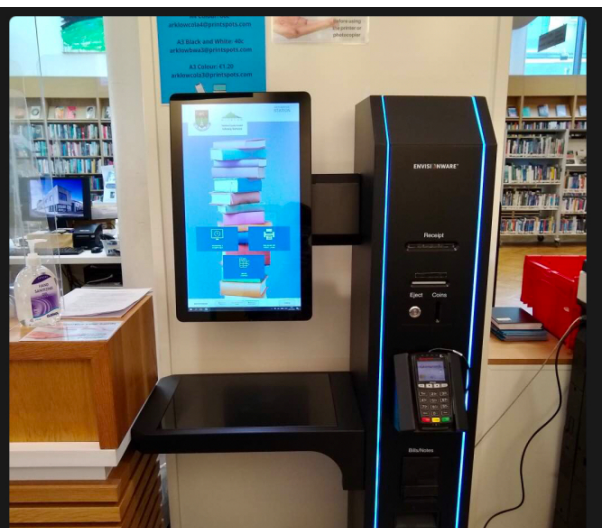
There are PCs available upstairs which you can use. You just need your library card number and your PIN. There are quiet areas where you are able to study.

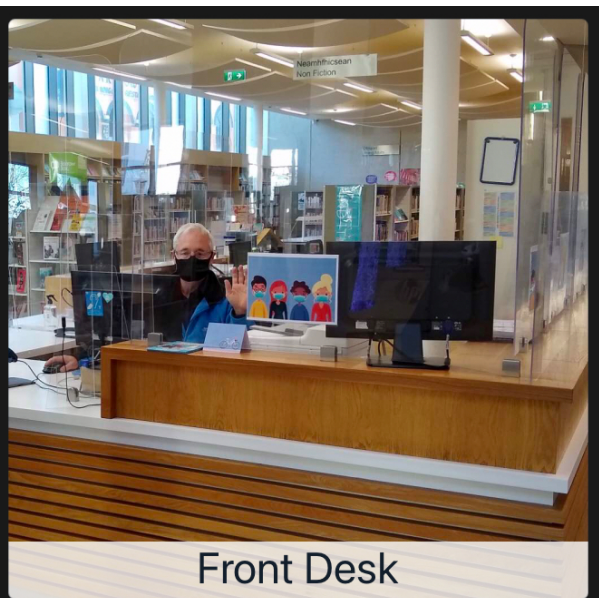
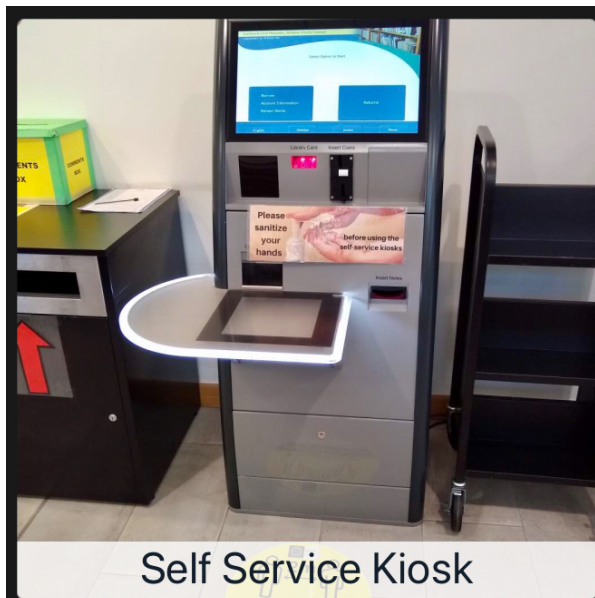


## CDs, DVDs and Audio Book
