

Arklow Parade Ground

Our vision is to create a pedestrian centric town core within Arklow to encourage activity and return some much needed vitality to the vicinity. The upgrade works will stimulate new growth within the town from a commercial point of view but also a way of improving the town from an aesthetic point of view. When the works are completed it will also improve traffic flow within the town centre and make it more appealing for people to spend time there and enjoy the new public area.

The planned development of the area will consist of the following key elements of work:

1. Re-alignment of the footpath on the church side of Main Street.
2. Creation of a dedicated pull-in area for buses with a covered shelter for people using public transport.
3. Construction of pedestrian crossings on St. Mary's Road and on Main Street adjacent to the Bank of Ireland.
4. Paving and landscaping of the area outside the church.
5. Removal of the walls and railings from the front of the courthouse building.
6. Paving and landscaping of the area outside the courthouse grounds.
