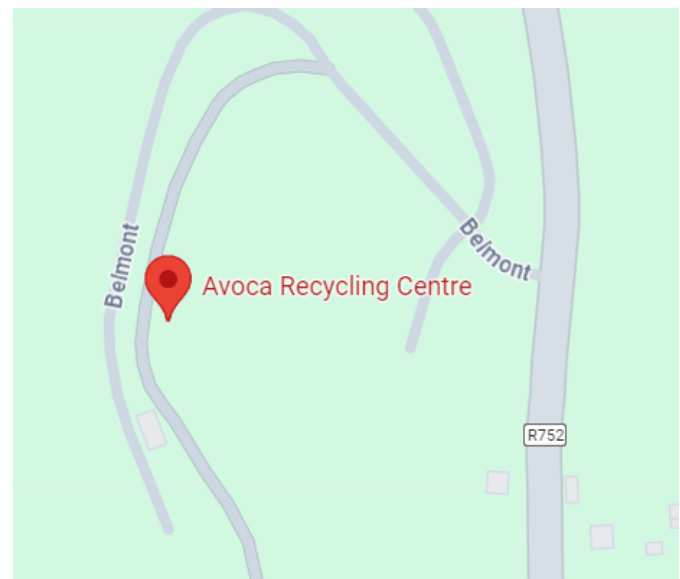

When Using the Centre

- Household use only, commercial waste will not be accepted on site.
 - To comply with Health and Safety Regulations users of this facility must exercise due care.
- Children must be supervised at all times.
 - Dogs must always be on a lead.
- Cardboard must be clean & flattened if possible.
- Glass should be clean, lids removed & colour sorted.
- Cans should be clean & sorted by type – food/drinks.
 - Clothing should be clean.
 - Shoes should be in pairs.
- All waste must be placed in the correct receptacle.
- Material should not be removed from the facility.

Gas Appliances - Gas Boilers and Gas Cookers Only

Glass - Clear, Brown, and Green Bottles and Jars (Blue Glass Can be Mixed with Brown), Glass Door (Shower), Glass Mirror (No Surrounds), Glass Plates, Window Glass

Lawnmower – Plug, Battery, and Petrol (Oil & Petrol Must be Removed)

Paper - Newspapers, Magazines, Shredded, Loose and Baled

Plastic - Bottles, Loose, Baled and Food Containers (Must be Cleaned)

Polystyrene - White Only (Due to variance in the manufacture of polystyrene please check with a staff member)

Roller Blinds - Metal Only

Steel - Food Cans Loose, Steel Scrap and Mixed Steel

Tetra Packs - Milk Cartons, Juice Cartons, etc

Waste Oil - Cooking Oil and Engine Oil

Pyrex, Crockery, Drinking Glasses, Window Frames, Fiberglass, Delph

Garden Waste

Plastic Wrapping

Biscuit, Sweet, Crisp Wrappers, Plant Pots, Potting Trays, Plastic Toys, Water Butts, Composters, Plastic Oil Tanks, Bubble Wrap

No Polystyrene Pellets, Beads, Film Coated Polystyrene or Foam, Attic Insulation

Ceramic Toilet, Mattresses, Construction & Demolition Waste

Tyres, Kerosene Tanks, Paint Cans (Full & Empty)
