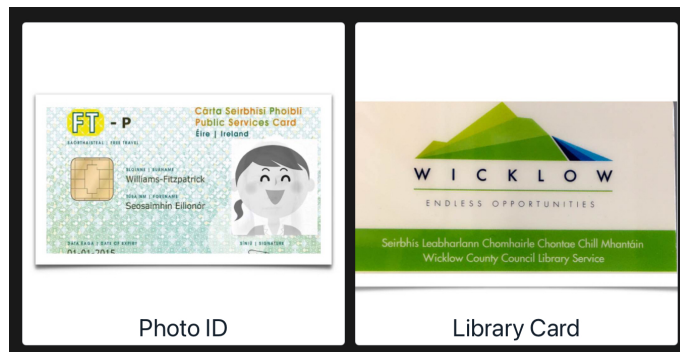




**We are really looking forward to welcoming you

For Kids, bring an adult with a library card (if the adult needs to join too, see above)

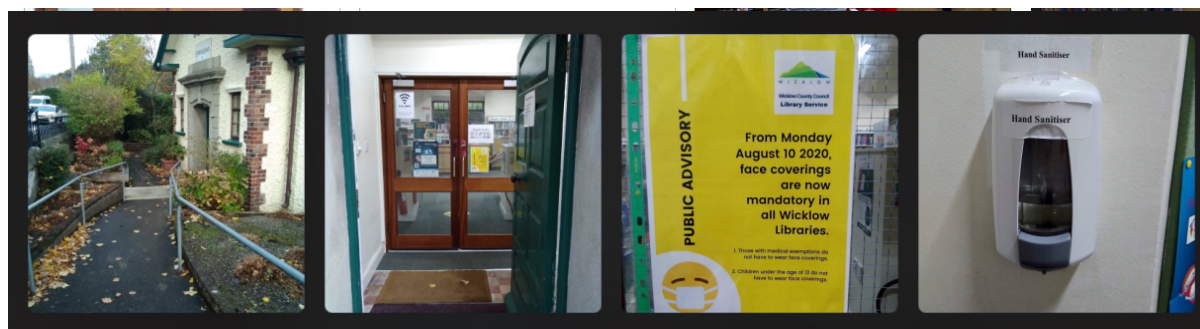
You can also register to join online before you arrive. Go to this link: <https://lgma.iii.com/selfreg> and complete the details. Once the form is filled you are given a number which you bring to the branch and from that we create the account and library card. Either way, it does not take long and we are happy to help. You can borrow on your first visit so be sure to bring your library bag to bring your books home.

What else do I need to know?

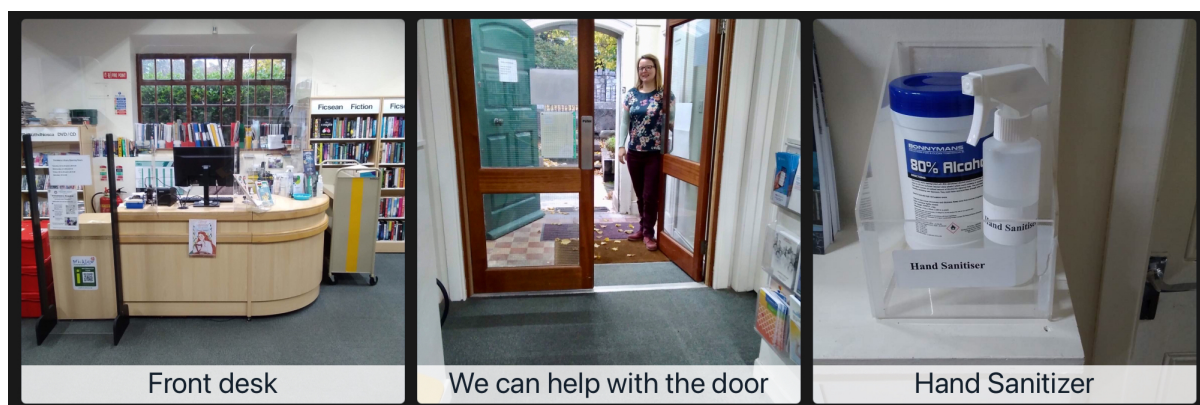
- You can borrow up to 12 items, including books
- You can keep your borrowed books for up to three weeks and can renew them twice if no one else is waiting for them.
- There are no late fees anymore.

## Visiting Enniskerry Library

There is a bus stop across the road from the branch and the buses are the 44 and 185. There is also free parking right beside the Library. Quiet days are Tuesdays and Rainy days.



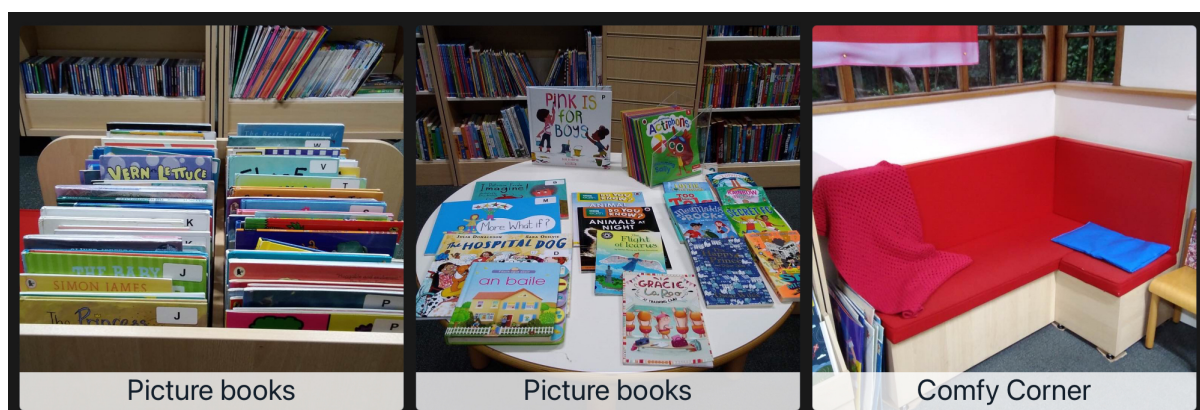
We have a gate entry on the street with a short ramp down to the front vestibule doors. Inside the vestibule shelter you will see our library rules on the glass doors. We ask you to wear a mask and use the sanitiser as you come in.



Just inside you will find our public bathroom which you are welcome to use. Directly opposite the doors you will see our front desk where you can check your membership card is active. If you need help with the doors, we will see you from there and come and give you a hand.

## Then it is time to go find a book!

Right next to the counter we have our picture books section which you can flick through in the bins or search by author. In this area we also have our display table, which changes from week to week. Choose some books to bring home, or sit down in the comfy corner and have a read for a while.

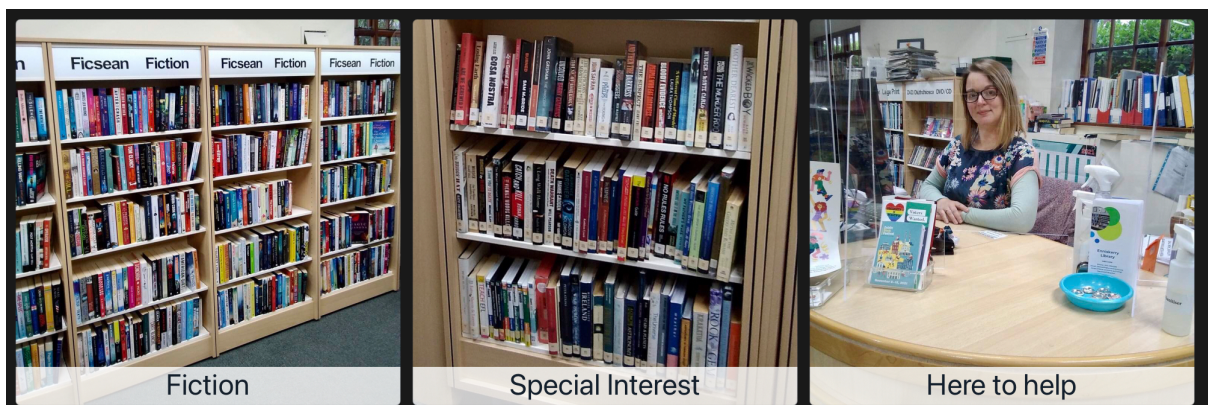
Ear Defenders
