To help you plan your first visit, here are a few things you need to know:

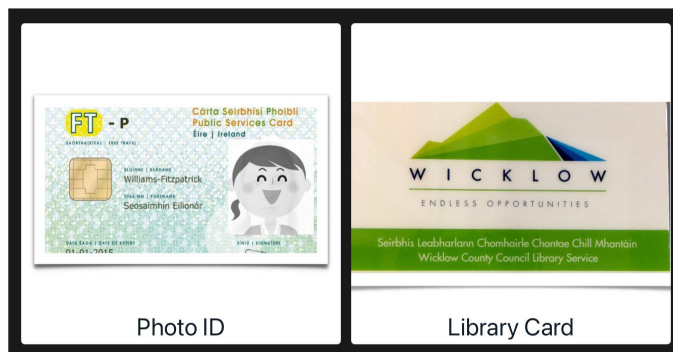


Photo ID

Library Card

For Adults: Please bring some photo ID and proof of your address, such as a bill or official letter. For Kids, bring an adult with a library card (if the adult needs to join too, see above)

You can also register to join online before you arrive. Go to this link: <https://lgma.iii.com/selfreg> and complete the details. You can borrow on your first visit so be sure to bring your library bag.

What else do I need to know?

- You can borrow up to 12 items, including books
- You can keep your borrowed books for up to three weeks and can renew them twice if no one else is waiting for them.
- There are no late fees anymore.

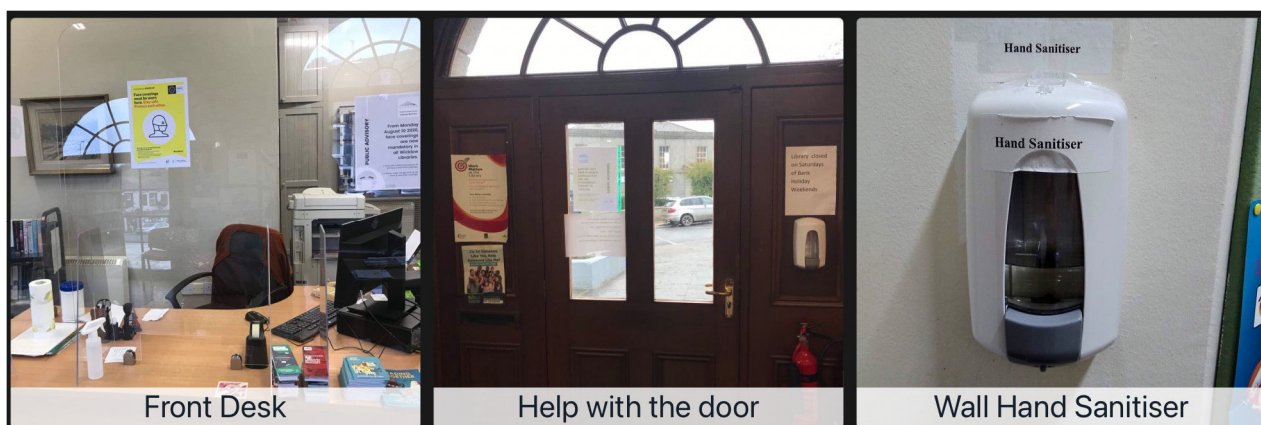
Visiting Tinahely Library

We are right in the middle of the village next to the Town Sign.

We are open from 1.30 to 5pm and 6.30 to 8.30 pm on Tuesday and Wednesday; and from 10.30 to 1.30 and 2.30 to 5pm Thursday and 10.30 to 1.30pm on Saturday. Closed on Saturdays of Bank Holiday Weekends.



There is parking right beside the library and a nice sloping path up to the side to the main entry. We ask you to wear a mask and use the sanitiser as you come in.



As you come you will see our front desk where you can check your membership card is active. If you need help with the doors, please call out and we will come and give you a hand.

Sensory Area

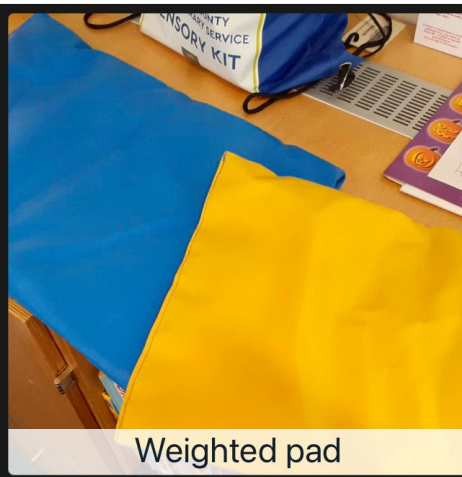


Take a seat

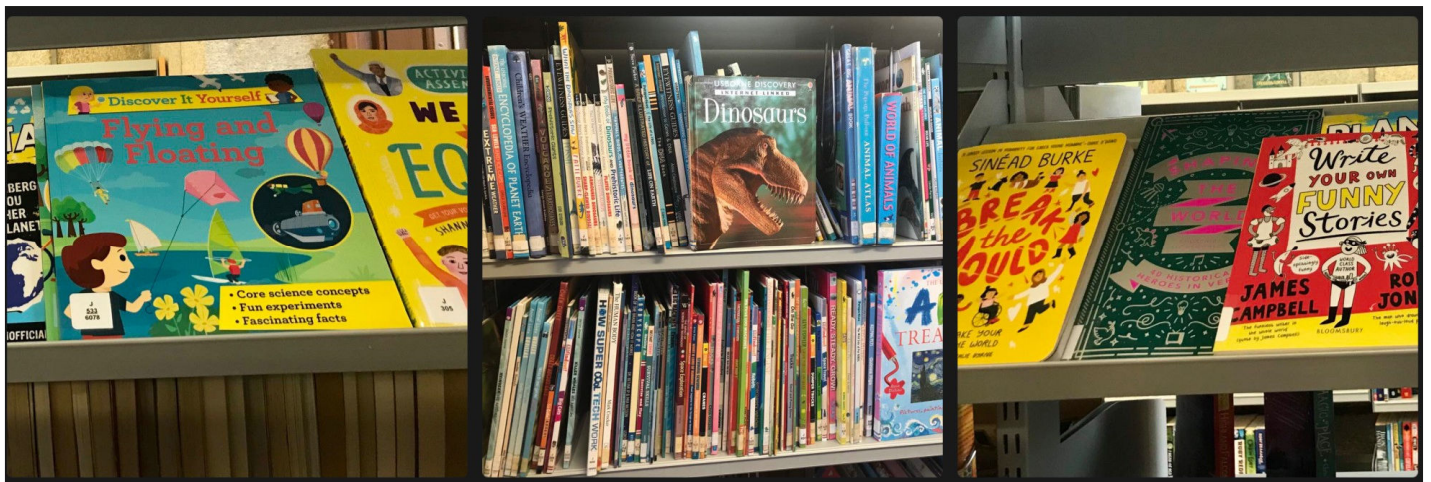


Junior Fiction
