

Policy for notice boards in Wicklow Libraries

Wicklow County Council libraries reserve the right to refuse to display any materials at the discretion of the Branch Librarian.

Notices may be displayed for up to two weeks at a time, but they may be removed sooner.

All posters and notices are to be displayed on library notice boards and must be typed or printed.

Priority will be given to:

- Wicklow Libraries information.
- Wicklow County Council information.
- Government information.
- Local information including events, entertainment, courses and classes.
- Information from national organizations.
- Non commercial information such as material from charities and voluntary or not-for-profit organizations.

We do not display:

- Any poster larger than A4.
- Party political or religious material.
- Any material which encourages discrimination on the grounds of race, gender, family status, civil status, sexual orientation, religion, age, disability or membership of the Traveller Community.
- Leaflets or personal notices selling items or services, e.g. childminding, flat rental.
- Collection boxes or petitions

Any items displayed on library notice boards are neither endorsed nor guaranteed by Wicklow County Council.

The Branch Librarian has the final decision on whether or not any notice should be displayed.
