Barony of Shillelagh & County of Wicklow.

The whole of this Psh. is the property of Earl Fitzwilliam. Agent Robt. Chaloner Esqre., Coolattin Parish. It is a Rectory in the Diocese of Leighlin Constituting the Corps of the Prebend of Aghold in the Cathedral Church of St. Lazerian, Leighlin, and Episcopally united to the Improprate Curacies of Creerin & Discoleman, which three 3 Pshes. form the union of Aghold in the Patronage of the Bishop of Leighlin, Ferns & Ossory. The Church was erected in 1716 and enlarged by said of a loan of £350 from the late Board of First Fruits in 1814, see (MS.) page 42 for further description. The Glebe Ho. was built by a gift of £100 and a loan of £1,350 from the same board. Glebe about 12 acres. There are four schools in the Psh., 3 in connection with Kildare Street Society and one Erasmus Smith's for their description see (MS.) pages 37, 13, 26 & 17. The principal seats are Munny, the residence of A.A. Nicholson Esqre. The Hall that of Mrs. Haskins, and Killenure that of A. Montfort Esqre. There is a Police Station in Munny Upper T.Ld. Petty Sessions are held every alternate Monday at Coolkenne. Site of a grave yard in Killinure T.Ld. Church ruins & grave yard in Aghold Lower T.Ld. Old Stone cross called St. Findens Cross near the N.W. corner of Church ruin; top of the shaft broken off & lying beside the pedestal. The Walls of the ancient church are the original height except a part of the South side wall. A corn mill in Killabeg T.Ld. and another in Killinure T.Ld. see (MS.) page 7. Market & Post town, Tullow, distant about five miles.

The Church is situated near the centre of Coolkenno Townland, it is capacious as the Protestant Population is numerous; it is in the form of the letter T with three Galleries. It was erected in 1716. The ruins of the ancient Church stand in Aghold Lower Townland, which being formerly much encompassed with bogs was difficult of approach in the time of winter. A representation to that effect was made to the Landlord, the Honble. Mr. Fitzwilliam who granted a new site where the present church was erected.
