The whole of this Psh. is the property of Barl Fitzwilliam. Agent Robt. Chaloner Esgre., Coolattin Parish. It is a Rectory in the Diocese of Leighlin Constituting the Corps of the Frebend of Aghold in the Cathedral Church of St. Lazerian. Leighlin, and Episcopally united to the Impropriate Curacies of Creerin & Liscoleman, which three 3 Pakes. form the union of Aghold in the Patronagh of the Bishop of Leighlin, Ferns & Ossory. The Church was erected in 1716 and enlarged by maid of a loan of £350 from the late Board of First Fruits in 1814, see (MS.) page 42 for further description. The Glebe Ho. was built by a gift of 11 0 and a loan of 21,350 from the same board. Globe about 12 scres. There are four schools in the 2sh., 3 in connection with Eildare Street Society and one Erasmus Smith's for their description see (MS.) pages 37, 13, 26 & 17. The principal seats are Munny, the residence of A.A. Nichson Esqre. The Hall that of Mrs. Haskins, and Killenure that of A. Montfort Esqre. There is a Police Station in Eunny Upper T.Ld. The Church is situated near the centre of Coolkenno Townland, it is capacious as the Protestant Population is numerous; it is in the form of the letter T with three Galleries. It was credted in 1716. The ruins of the ancient Church stand in Aghold lower Townland, which being formerly much encompassed with bogs was difficult of approach in the time of winter. A representation to that effect was made to the Landlord, the Honble. Er. Fitswilliam who granted a new site where the present church was erected.
