"Wicklow County Council is calling on the Minister for Justice to introduce legislation for stricter penalties on those that are found guilty of damaging or tampering with defibrillators and life buoys.

Damage to, or theft of a defibrillator/life buoy are installed for public use could be a death sentence for a patient if they were not available for a patient in cardiac arrest or a life buoy if drowning. It is that serious. Locking up AEDs or life buoys isn't the ideal solution - you wouldn't lock up a fire extinguisher'.
