Observation relevant to the settlement:

SLO - GDK59R -Pedestrian and cycling infrastructure from Prettybush Corner to Kilquade.

This proposal runs along the Kilquade Road to just Kilquade. As a resident of Kilquade Hill and a frequent cyclist and walker on this road I am requesting you extend this SLO to include all of Kilquade Road from Pettybush corner to Woodstock Road for a number of reasons. (see my map below with the road outlined in yellow)

- 1. There are volumes of walkers runners and cyclists along this road and the whole length of this road requires cycling and pedestrian improvement and safety.
- 2. This road server the population of the Garden Village, Kilguade Hill and Kilcoole residents.
- 3. Extending SLO GDK59R along this road would nicely link up with SLO GDK59C and SLO GDK59B giving improved pedestrian and cycling facilities.
- 4. While the residents successfully campaigned for the 50KM speed limit on Kilquade Road, there are increased volumes of traffic and speed on this road, as a lot of traffic uses this road as a rat run to avoid the traffic lights and traffic delays in Kilcoole and Newtown Mount Kennedy The Kilquade Road in the interim badly needs traffic calming measures and more speed signs on this road.
