Wicklow, by way of an 18-month lease for the period 9th July 2021 to 8th January 2023 and the right to pass and repass thereto, to Mr. Noel Jacob and Ms. Helen Jacob, Jacob's Well, Rathdrum, Co. Wicklow, as set out in Statutory Notice circulated.

Prior to discussion on Item 5, Cllr. A. Flynn-Kennedy disclosed to the meeting the nature of a beneficial interest and withdrew fully from the meeting by disconnecting remote connection for consideration of the item.

ITEM NO. 5

To consider the disposal of 112 square meters of land or thereabouts comprised within Folio WW6353L situated in the townland of Beechwood Close, Boghall Rd, Bray, Co. Wicklow, A98 W3P3, originally acquired from The Central Garage (Bray) Ltd. by entering an agreement with ARK Housing Association by way of lease, for a period of 24 months.

It was proposed by Cllr. I. Winters, seconded by Cllr. J. Snell and agreed to dispose of 112 square meters of land or thereabouts comprised within Folio WW6353L situated in the townland of Beechwood Close, Boghall Rd, Bray, Co. Wicklow, A98 W3P3, originally acquired from The Central Garage (Bray) Ltd. by entering an agreement with ARK Housing Association by way of lease, for a period of 24 months, as set out in Statutory Notice circulated.

ITEM NO. 6

To consider entering into a Section 85 Agreement with Kildare County Council – Completion of the Blessington Lakes eGreenway

Mr. F. Curran, Chief Executive advised of the following:

- Agreement refers to a small section of the greenway there is a footpath on the N81.
- For completeness, a Section 85 agreement is required.

- Kildare County Council agreed to the Section 85 Agreement at their last meeting.
- Considerable work done by Mr. D. O'Brien, Executive Engineer and Ms. M. Hartnett, Senior Executive Engineer.
- There is detailed design, new route, car parking and tarmacadam surface,
- Everything is in place to go to An Bord Pleanála and ready to start construction as soon as the board process is complete.

It was proposed by Cllr. P. Glennon, seconded by Cllr. E. Timmins and agreed to enter into a Section 85 Agreement with Kildare County Council – Completion of the Blessington Lakes eGreenway.

Presentation by Department of Environment, Climate & Communications on the Draft Policy Statement on Mineral Exploration and Mining

Mr. Eoin Deegan, Principal Officer gave a presentation outlining the following:

- Section 1. Minerals What are they? Why are they important? Where do we get them?
- Section 2. Policy context.
- Section 3. Regulatory Framework Exploration Mining.
- Section 4. Policy ensure a robust and transparent regulatory framework that supports environmentally sustainable mineral exploration and mining and maximise the contribution that the sustainable exploration and mining sector makes to our society, economic development and the transition to net-zero greenhouse gas emissions through the supply of the raw materials necessary for our sustainable development.
- Section 4.1. Policy Key principles
 - 1. Robust Regulation
 - 2. Increasing awareness and participation
 - 3. Sustainable development
 - 4. Building capacity and access to knowledge
 - 5. International co-operation
- Section 4.2. Policy Key priorities

- 1. Building Public Understanding and Trust
- 2. Enhancing the Regulatory Framework
- 3. Research on the role of minerals in the transition to net-zero (2050)
- 4. Better data enhancing policy and decision-making
- 5. Monitoring, review and reporting
- Key messages
 - 1. Minerals matter
 - 2. Need to redesign, reuse, repair & recycle, but primary minerals still required

The Elected Members were requested to make a submission on the draft policy.

Suspension of Standing Orders

Cllr. J. Behan requested the suspension of standing orders, seconded by Cllr. T. Fortune, to allow the Elected Members to discuss the threats to the role of councillors and Joint Policing Committees given recent suggestions that their composition and governance will be removed from councils in the near future. Cllr. Behan asked the Chief Executive if he was aware of plans to change the structure of the Joint Policing Committees, and how it will impact the role of the Elected Members.

The Chief Executive advised that there are new draft guidelines setting out the role of the Joint Policing Committees and councillors are very much a part of it. They include indicative compositions, 45% councillors i.e. 14 councillors on committees, Wicklow County Council currently have 15 councillors. The chairperson on the Joint Policing Committee would also continue to be an Elected Member.

The Chief Executive also advised that the focus is on working with the Gardaí and community in terms of policy development and highlighting what trends are in the county at a particular time.
