This 'How to' guide has been prepared to help you undertake **Part 1** of your Call for Sites submission; to use the Call for Sites self-reporting tool provided by Wicklow County Council to generate your site report.

This guide has two sections and uses examples to illustrate the steps to take to:

- A. Outline your site on the interactive web map and generate your site report.
- B. Reviewing your site for physical and planning characteristics and, if necessary, amending your site boundary.

The examples used are of land owned by Wicklow County Council and are for illustrative purposes only; it does not indicate any zoning intentions for these lands.

Please see the online consultation portal for further details on the consultation, detailed guidance on how to make a submission, the criteria Wicklow County Council will be using to identify land/sites and the next steps in the process.

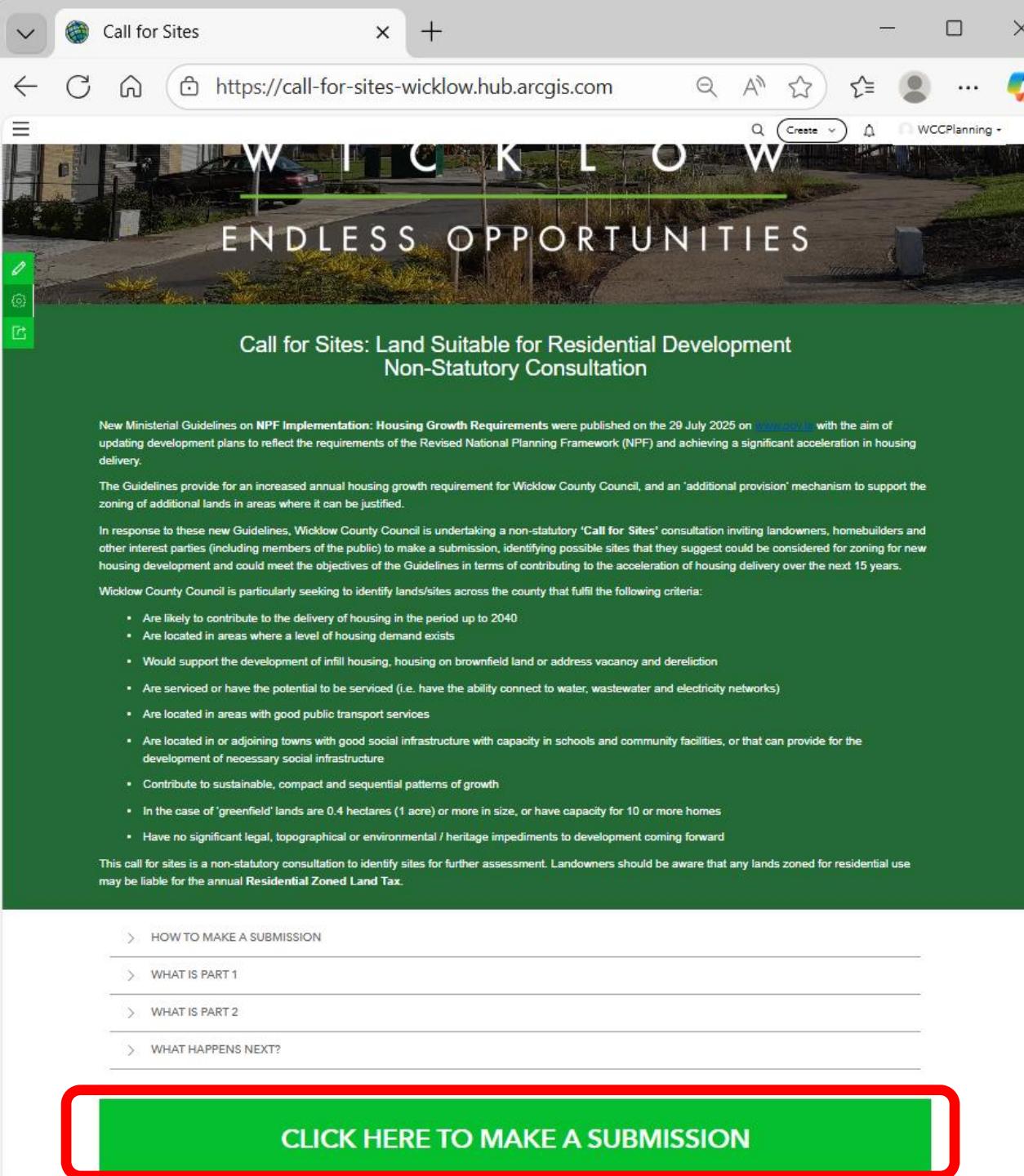

New Ministerial Guidelines on NPF Implementation: Housing Growth Requirements were published on the 29 July 2025 on www.gov.ie with the aim of updating development plans to reflect the requirements of the Revised National Planning Framework (NPF) and achieving a significant acceleration in housing delivery.

The Guidelines provide for an increased annual housing growth requirement for Wicklow County Council, and an 'additional provision' mechanism to support the zoning of additional lands in areas where it can be justified.

In response to these new Guidelines, Wicklow County Council is undertaking a non-statutory 'Call for Sites' consultation inviting landowners, homebuilders and other interest parties (including members of the public) to make a submission, identifying possible sites that they suggest could be considered for zoning for new housing development and could meet the objectives of the Guidelines in terms of contributing to the acceleration of housing delivery over the next 15 years.

Wicklow County Council is particularly seeking to identify lands/sites across the county that fulfil the following criteria:

- Are likely to contribute to the delivery of housing in the period up to 2040
- Are located in areas where a level of housing demand exists
- Would support the development of infill housing, housing on brownfield land or address vacancy and dereliction
- Are serviced or have the potential to be serviced (i.e. have the ability connect to water, wastewater and electricity networks)
- Are located in areas with good public transport services
- Are located in or adjoining towns with good social infrastructure with capacity in schools and community facilities, or that can provide for the development of necessary social infrastructure
- Contribute to sustainable, compact and sequential patterns of growth
- In the case of 'greenfield' lands are 0.4 hectares (1 acre) or more in size, or have capacity for 10 or more homes
- Have no significant legal, topographical or environmental / heritage impediments to development coming forward

This call for sites is a non-statutory consultation to identify sites for further assessment. Landowners should be aware that any lands zoned for residential use may be liable for the annual Residential Zoned Land Tax.

Submission: Part 1

Part 1 of the process requires you to identify the site in question using a map portal provided by the Council and generate a 'site report' from that portal. You will need the information from this site report to assist you in completing Part 2 of the application.

Guidance on how to generate this site report is outlined at the bottom of this webpage.

This map portal and the report it generates identifies key physical and planning characteristics of the land you have marked, that may impact on its suitability for residential development. In particular, this map will identify:

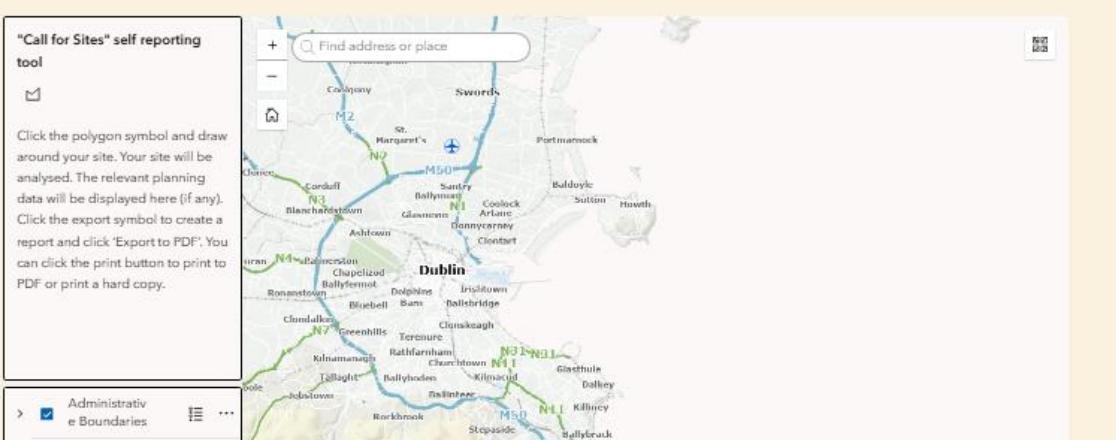
- If the land is already zoned fully or in part for residential use, which would signify that you may not need to request residential zoning. If the land is already fully zoned for residential use or a use that allows for residential development (e.g. town centre use) please be advised that it is highly unlikely that you need to make a submission
- If the land is located in an existing town or village; the proximity of the land to an existing town or village and its associated infrastructure would have a strong bearing on the suitability of land for new residential development
- If the land is fully or partly at risk of flooding; land at risk of flooding is normally not suitable for new residential development
- If the land is fully or partly subject to an environmental designation or protected natural features (such as protected European sites, watercourses, protected trees etc); a number of such designations could preclude or significantly limit residential development possibilities
- If the land is fully or partly subject to protection with respect to archaeology or architectural heritage (e.g. national monuments, protected structures); a number of such designations could impact on residential development possibilities
- If the land is fully or partly subject to any objectives or designations in the Wicklow County Development Plan that might impact on residential development possibilities, (e.g. landscape protections, listed views / prospects etc)

Once you generate this report, you should consider its contents carefully in order to determine if you wish to continue to make a zoning request in light of the information provided or if you may want to revise the boundaries of the proposed site to avoid any sensitivities identified.

The map created by the portal and associated site report should be downloaded and saved as they will be needed to carry out Part 2 of the process.

To do this, select the polygon box on the top left corner of the page. Once selected it will turn blue, confirming that this feature is turned on.

A PDF copy of the questionnaire can be downloaded from the consultation portal. We recommend that you review it and prepare your answers in advance.

At the end of the questionnaire you will be asked to read a number of declarations and confirm your understanding of them, before finalising and making your submission.



B: Reviewing the site's physical & planning characteristics

When you generate your site report you may find that there are physical and planning characteristics within the site boundary that may impact on its suitability for residential development. There may also be sensitive characteristics outside of the site boundary that could still be unacceptably impacted by a development.

In this case, you may want to amend your site boundaries.

The following pages will show you how to see these different characteristics on the map and how to amend your site boundaries accordingly.

Please note that the Call for Sites self reporting tool identifies key physical and planning characteristics of the land. There may be other relevant features that may affect development of your site – these will be considered as part of a more detailed evaluation in due course. However, please any include relevant considerations in your response to the Part 2 questionnaire.

The map then shows these characteristics as map features.

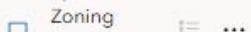

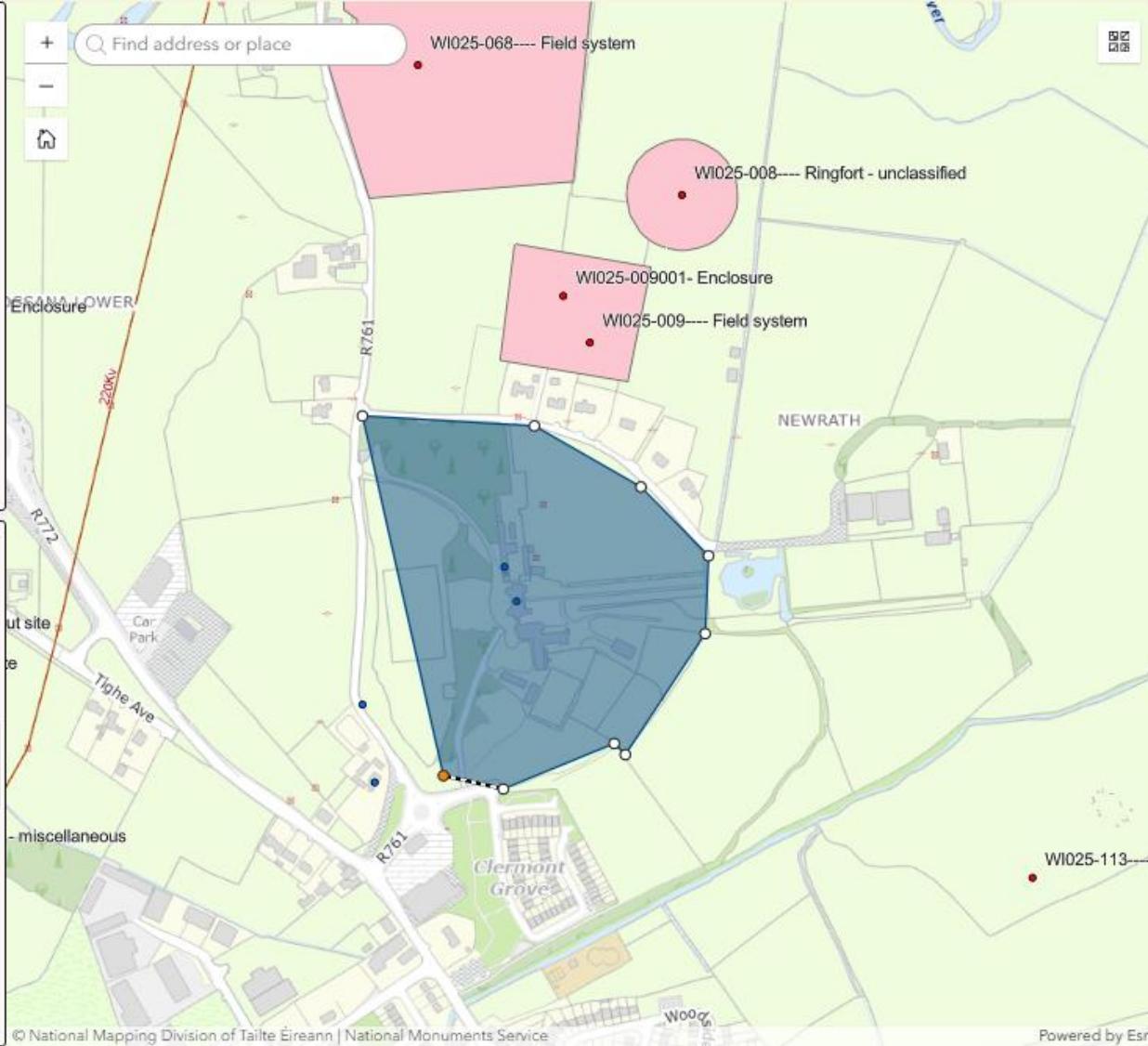

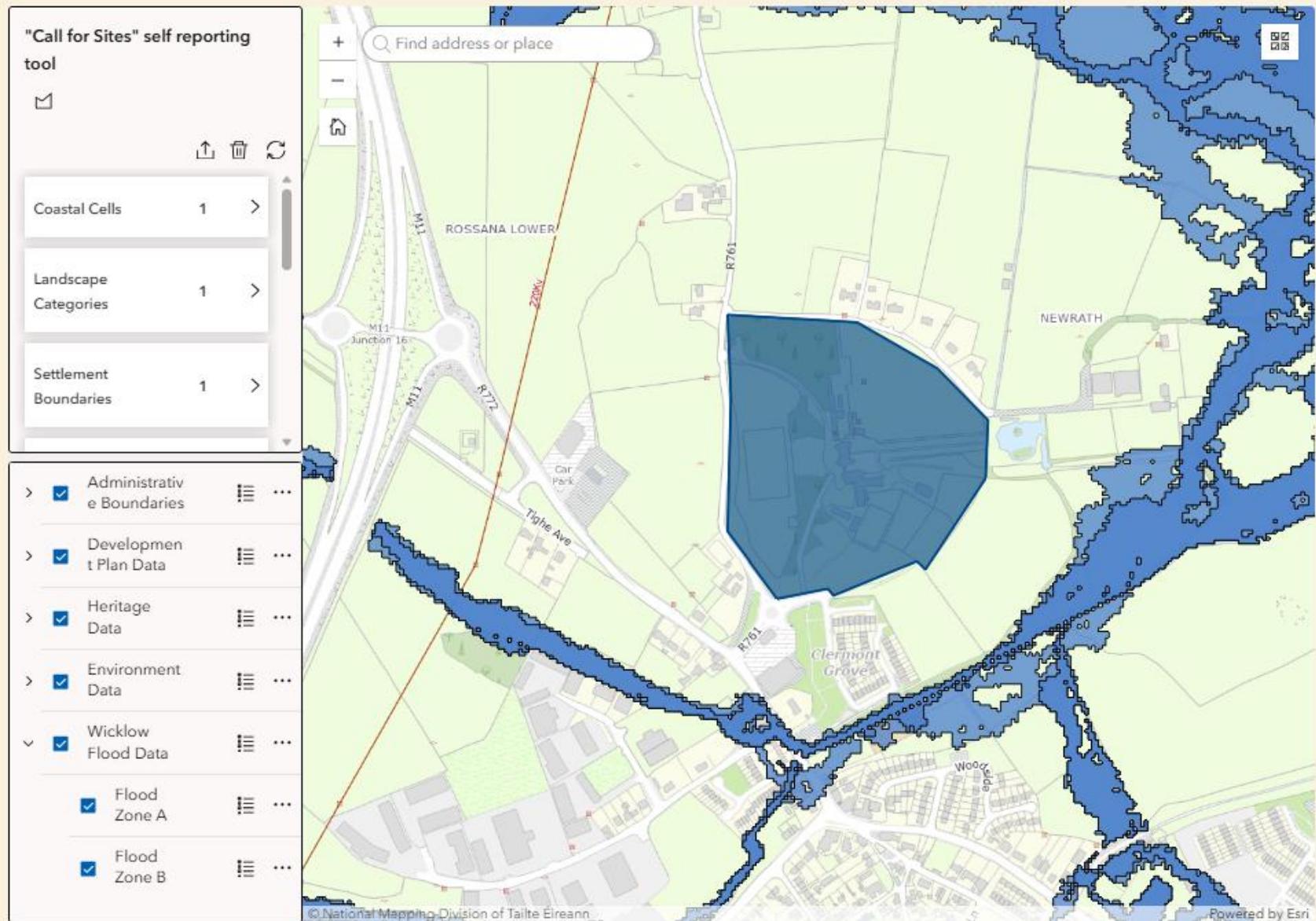

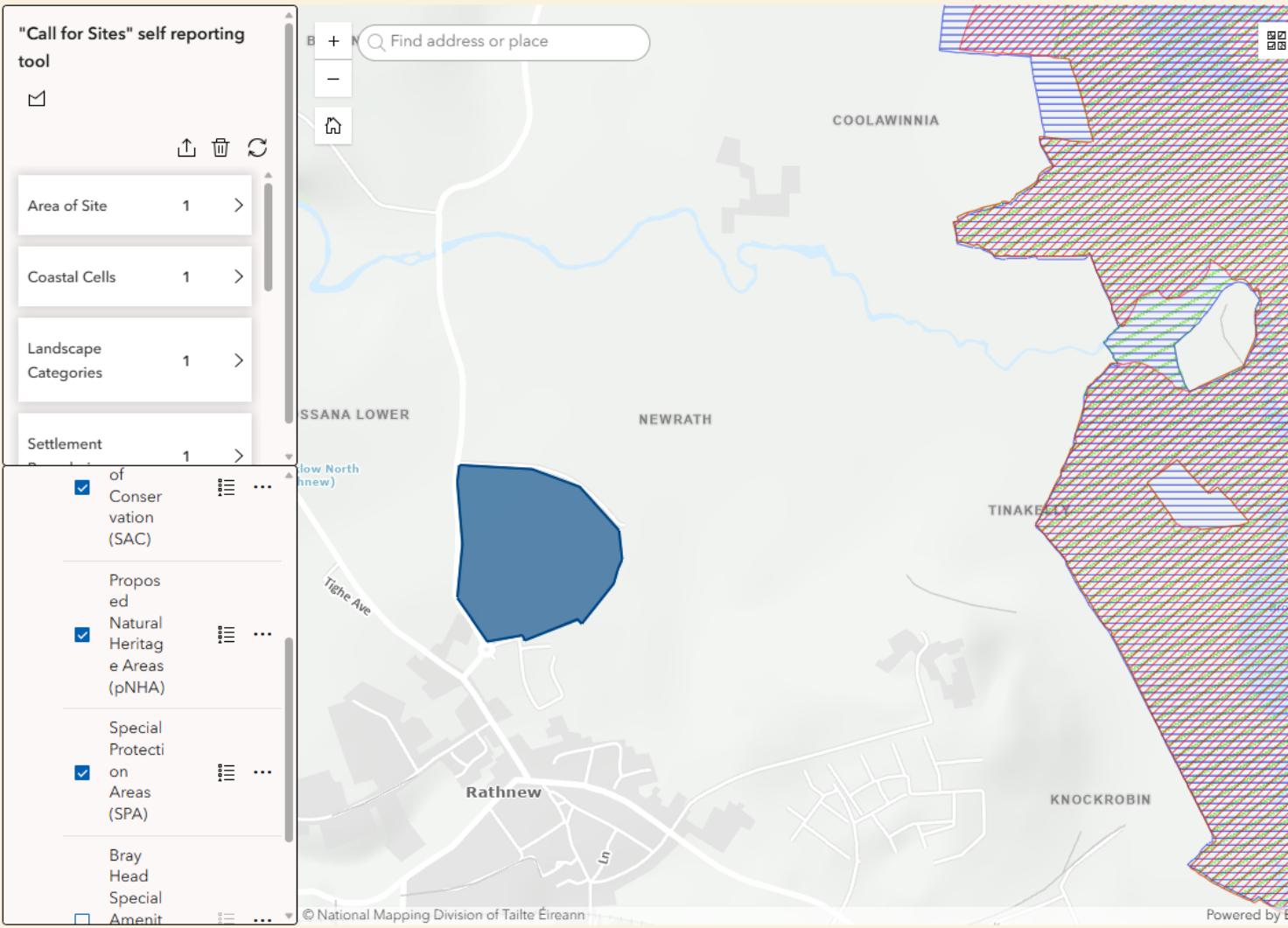
The site boundary can then be drawn with these characteristics in mind.

Again, in the Call for Sites Questionnaire (Part 2) you will need to provide a brief response outlining how you think residential development could appropriately come forward having regard to these characteristics.



Similarly, you can check for other characteristics, such as flood zones.

In this case, the site boundary is not in a flood zone area.



You can also check for other sensitive characteristics.

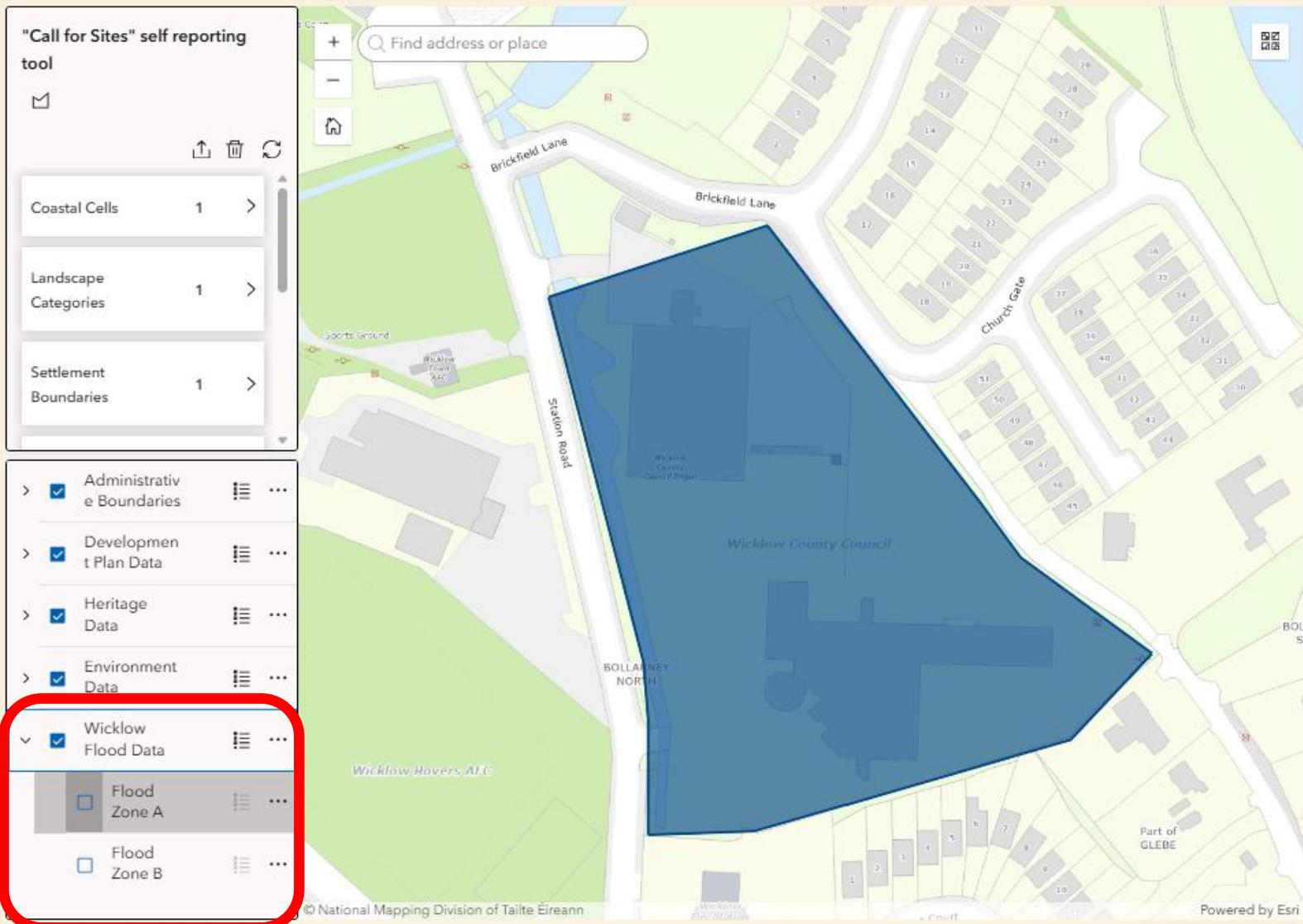
In this case we have turned on the Special Area of Conservation and, Special Protection Area (SPA) features to see whether they are in proximity to the site.

By zooming out on the map we can see they are further away.

However, not being in the immediate vicinity of a sensitive characteristic does not mean that a development will be acceptable. For example, developments upstream of a SPA can still cause unacceptable impacts.

Therefore, such potential impacts will need to be considered as part of the further review of any potential land use zonings.

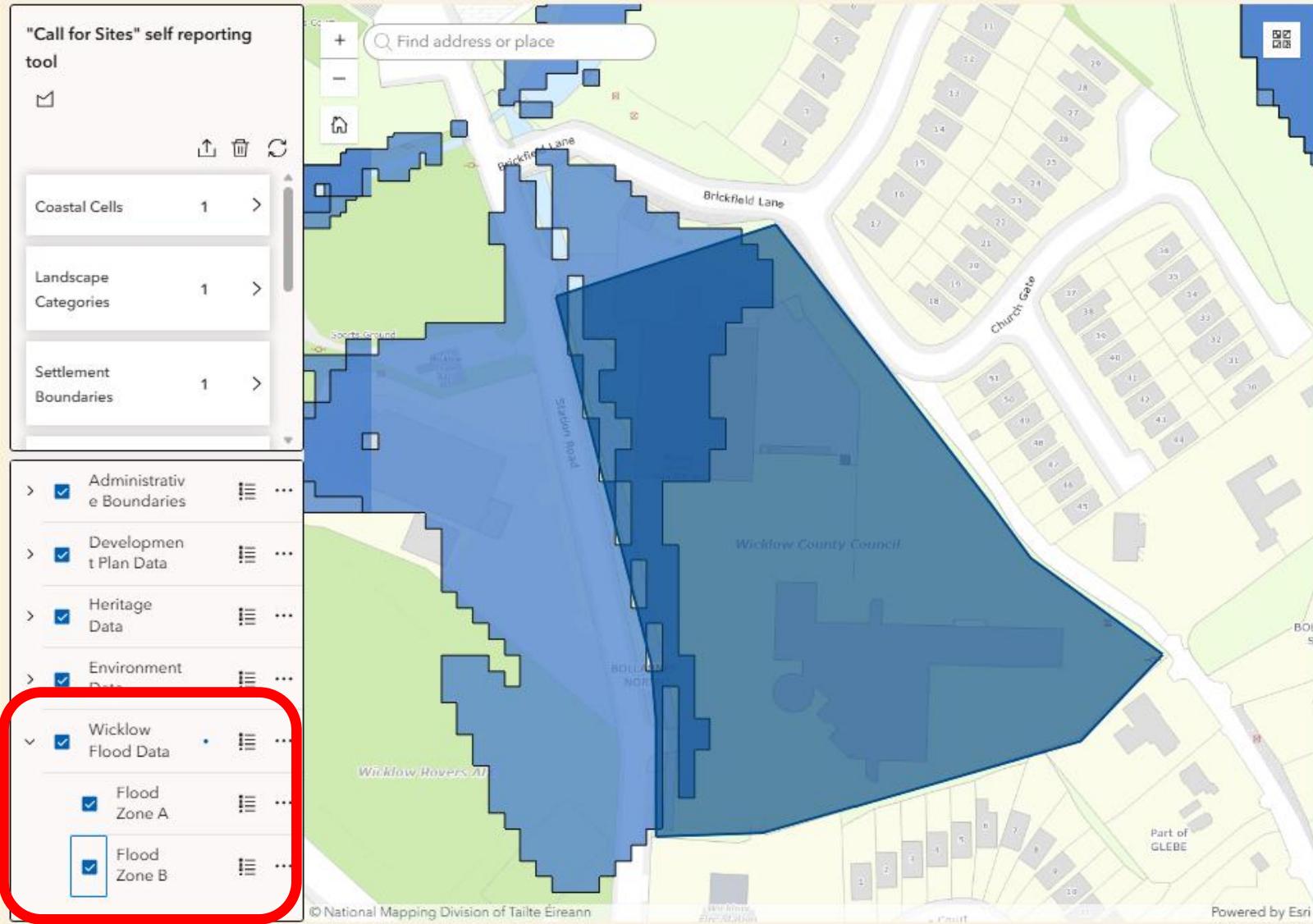




In the example of Wicklow County Council's offices the site report stated that the boundary includes areas of Flood Zone A and Flood Zone B, areas where residential zoning is very unlikely to be possible.

You can display these characteristics on the map by selecting the 'Wicklow Flood Data' drop down box and selecting the resulting boxes.

Doing so will 'turn on' the Flood Zone features.



You can now see the flood zone areas along with your site outline.

The flood zone covers only part of the site.

By clicking on the map feature information on this characteristic will appear.

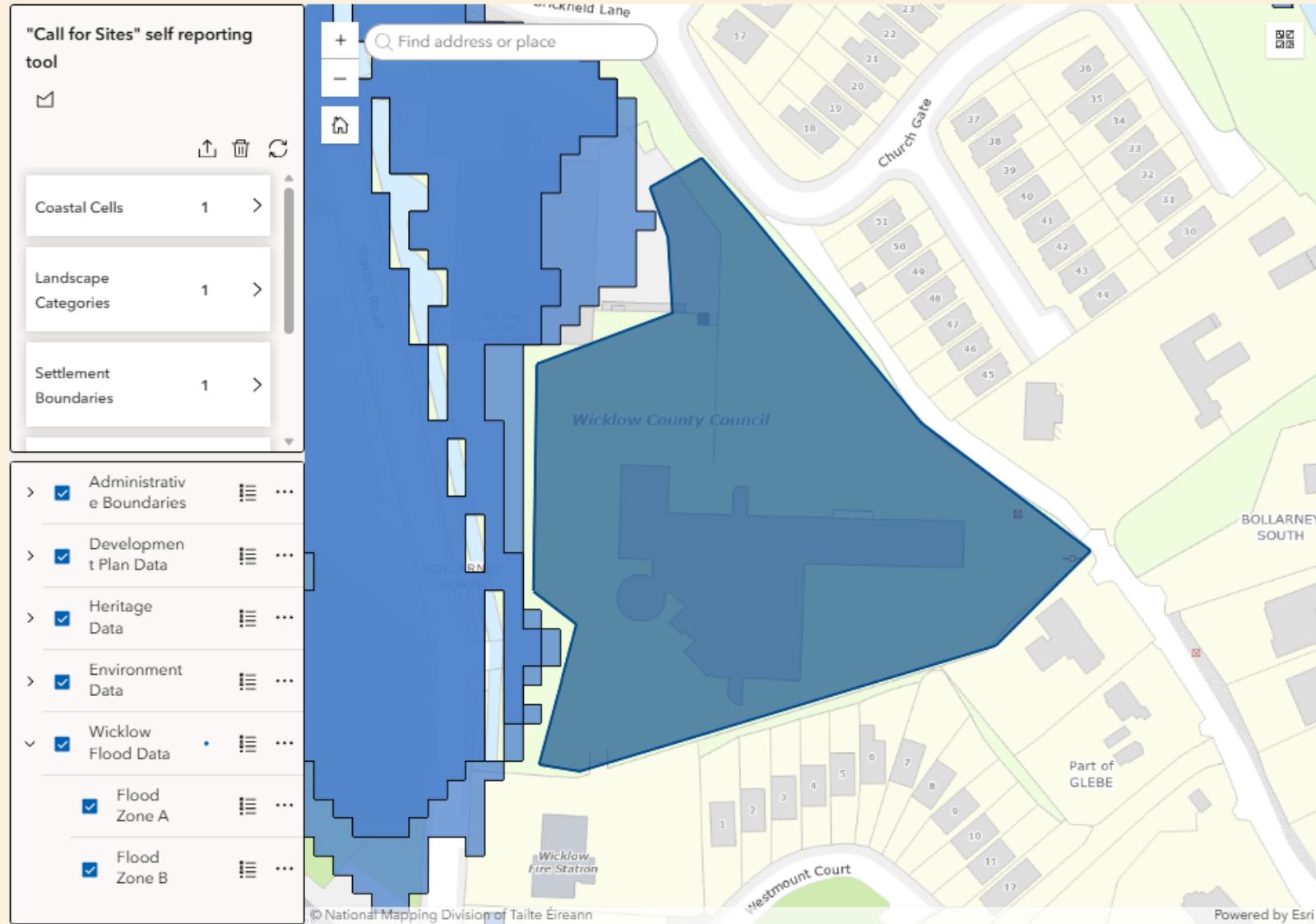

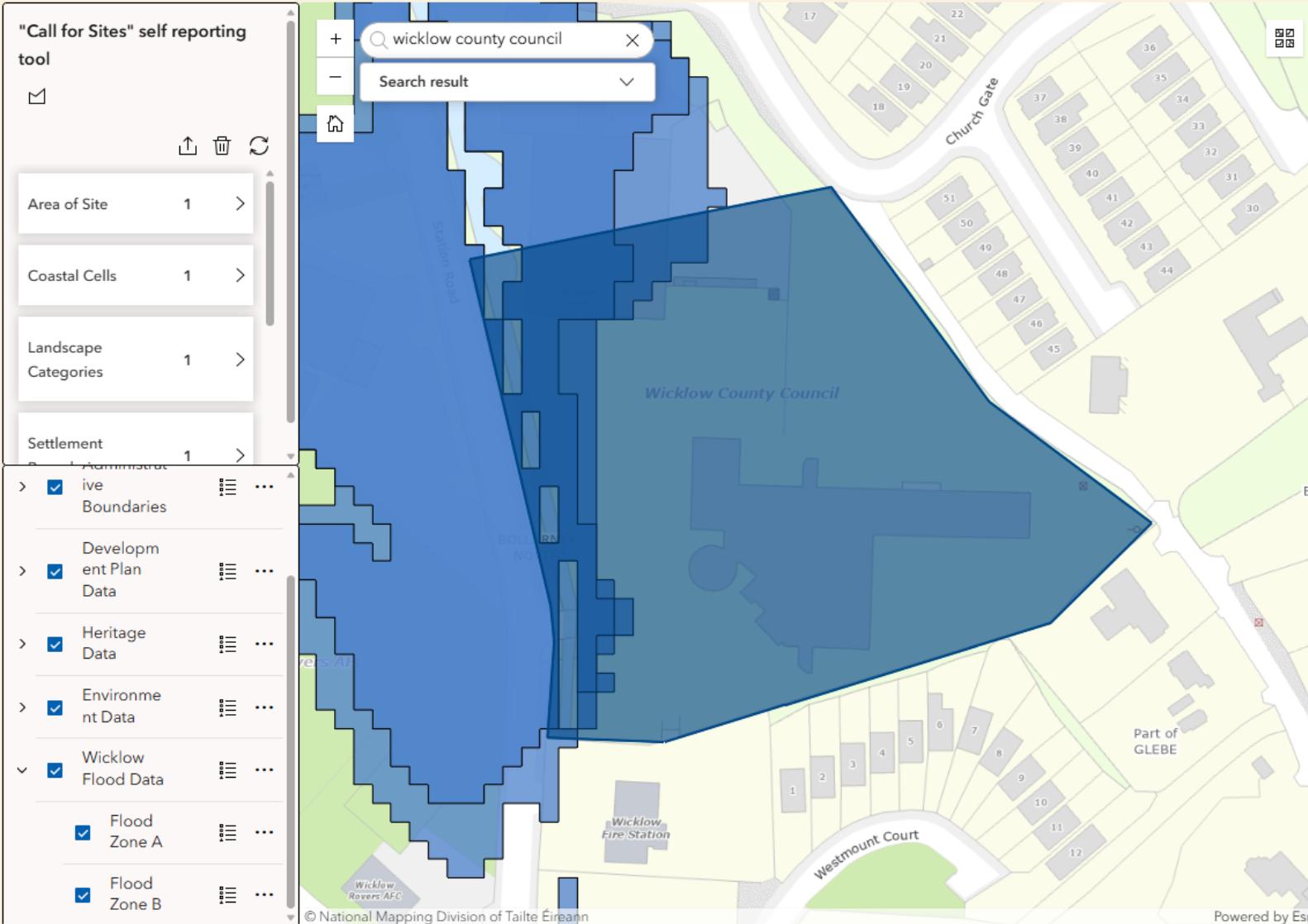


In the case of the flood zones, you may wish to redraw your site boundary.

To do so, click the button on the top left hand side of the map and you can redraw your boundary.



You could redraw your boundary to entirely avoid the flood zone; however, in this case, the site would not have access to Station Road, which would mean that it could not be accessed or serviced.



Therefore, in this case you would choose to either not proceed with your submission for this site **or** to amend the boundary to include access from the road, including an area of flood zone.
