This Parish is in the Province of Leinster, about four miles from Baltinglass. It is a vicarage in the Diocese of Leighlin, episcopally united to the Rectory and is a vicarage of Kilranelagh and is in the patronage of the Bishop and Government. The Rectory is impropriate in Sir R. Steele Bart. Tithes amount to about £516, £340 of which is payable to the impropriator. The glebe comprises about 20 acres for which £2. per acre is paid. Kiltegan church is a handsome edifice with embattled tower and spire erected by a gift of £500 and a loan of £320 from the Board of First fruits; it was further enlarged in 1822 at the expence of £1,200. The Glebe house is occupied by the vicar. 2

There is a Dispensary and penny post from Baltinglass in the Village with xxix parish of Kiltegan, also a school endowed by the trustees of Erasmus Smith with £30 yearly for teaching 20 scholars free; there are two other schools

in the Psh., one in Upper Killamote T.Ld. near the Chapel and the other in Mullenacranoe T.Ld. The Roman Catholic Chapel is in Lower Killamote T.Ld. There are two grave yards one in Cranerin T.Ld. and the other in Kiltegen T.Ld. one third of a mile East of Church besides the one in which is the Church.

There is a Police Station about the Middle of the Psh. in Cornawn East. There are two handsome seats in the Parish, that of E. Westby Esqre., Highpark in a Demesne of about 400 acres, which contains some fine old timber and that of Mrs. Hume, Hume wood, which is also surrounded by good timber in the Demesne. The original mansion of Highpark was burnt by the insurgents in 1798. On opening a Rath at Highpark about three years ago, an urn of coarse pottery was discovered which contained ashes and bones. There is a patent for eight fairs in the year, but none are held. There are two ancient wells in the Psh., one in Rathdangan T.Ld. called Tubberowen and the other in Cornawn East called Tubbernathunkill. The river Deereen takes its source at the North corner of the Psh. and the Douglass River in the T.Ld. of Lower Muckduff. The road from Baltingless to Rathdrum runs through the middle of the Parish from West to East. The principal Proprietors of the Psh. are the Earl Fitzwilliam, Col. Howard and E. Westby Esqre. A great portion of the Psh. is bog and Mountain, particularly the North and East sides. There is much limestone gravel in the Psh. which is burnt for manure, but the land in general is so light that it is not used in many cases to advantage.
