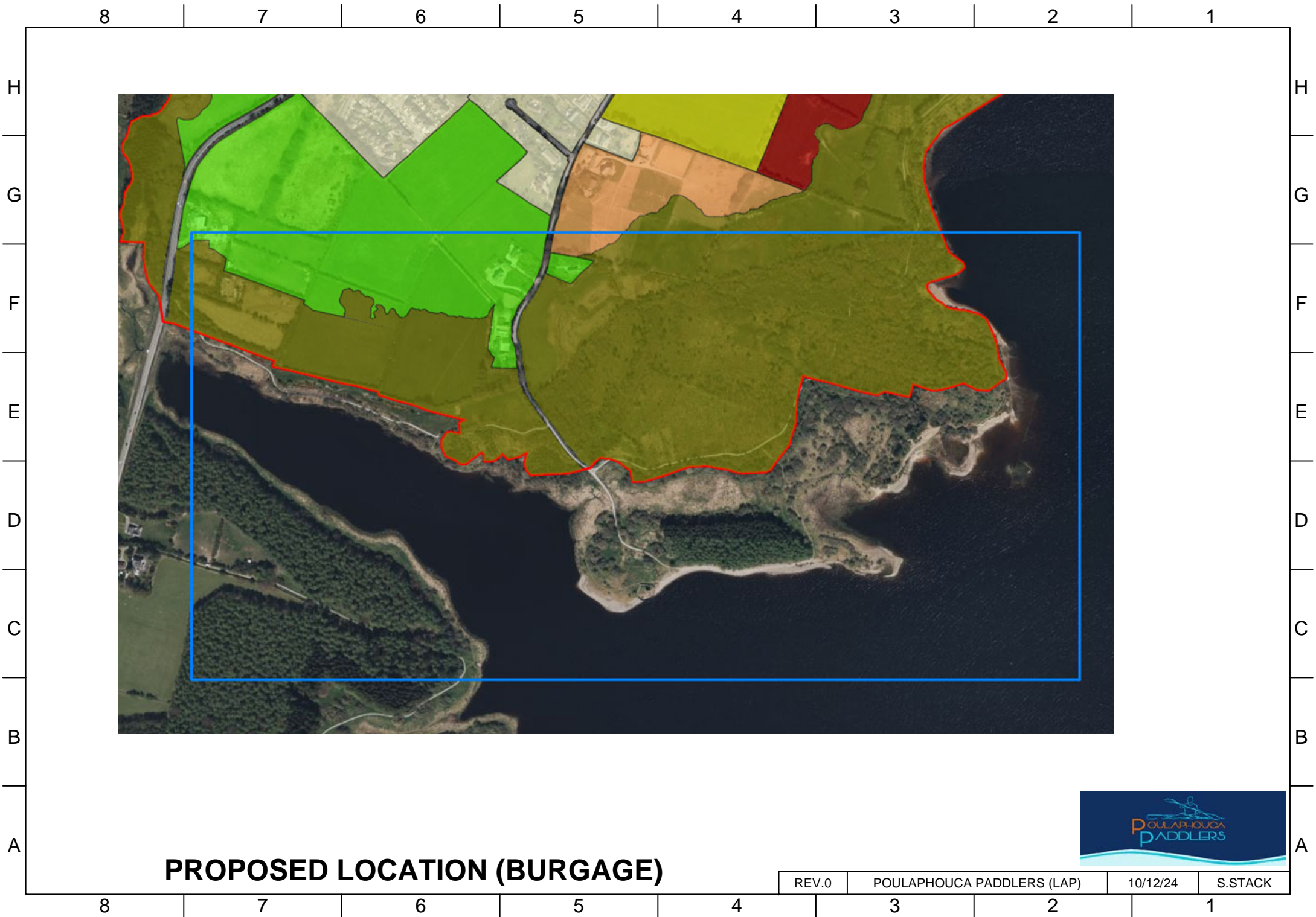


Organised trips
