Contains 8640 acres 2 roads¹ 2 pers. Statute Measure of which 433 acres 20 pers. are uncultivated and 207 acres 3 roads of water. The Venerable Archdeacon Magee is Rector & The Rev. Francis Chamley Vicar of the Parish. The Parish Church, Roman Catholic Chapel & Methodist Meeting 2 House are all situated in the Town of Wicklow. The Inhabitants are about one third Protestant & 2/3 Protestant Dissenters & two thirds Roman Catholics. The Town of Wicklow is just getting into repute as a Bathing place. The Port of Wicklow has a Bar at the entrance of the river, which prevents vessels drawing more than eight feet of water from entering, and they only at high tides. There is also a Custom house, having the following officers 3 a Collector Tide Surveyor & Tide Welter, a chief office & a party of the Coast Guards are stationed in the Town and also a few constabulary. In this part of the town are two Hotels.

Parish of Rathnew (contd.)

The Imports are Coals from Whitehaven & Swansea, Limestone from Skerries, Slates from Bangor, Timber (occasionally only) from Quebec & Herrings from Scotland. The exports are Copper Ore to Wales & Corn to Liverpool & Preston. The principal Merchants are Messrs. Ferrin, Nolans, Pims, Travers and Barrys. The only manufacture (if such it can be called) is lime burning which is carried to a very great extent. A new pier & Harbour have been in contemplation for some years. Two Caravans start daily (except Sundays) for Dublin at 6 o'clock a.m. and return & same day at 3 o'clock p.m.
