This Parish is in the County of Wicklow and Province of Leinster about a mile N.W. from Baltinglass. It is one of the three parishes forming the Union of Baltinglass in the Diocese of Leighlin. The church is a neat building near the N.W. corner of the Psh.; it has a square tower crowned with pinnacles. There is no Glebe house, the curate residing in a very small house nearly three miles from the church. The Ph. contains 7404 acres 1 rood 21 pers.

the whole of which is under cultivation except a few acres at top of Finoran hill and a few very small patches of marsh. The land principally under oats and potatoes. There being no Turbary in the Psh. fuel is very scarce and has to be brought from the distance of about five or six miles from Harraghmore Bogs. In the centre of the North portion of the (Ph.?) is Bumbohall a small village containing the Roman Catholic Chapel, Police Station and National School. Ballynure the principal seat in the Psh. situated in a rich Demesne is inhabited by its proprietor H. Carroll Esqre. It is an elegant mansion and has excellent office houses and garden attached. Grangecon situated also in a rich Demesne was formerly the grange of the Abbey of Baltinglass which together with the large Estate surrounding was granted by Queen Elizabeth to Sir J. Harrington. H. Harrington Esqre. till lately resided here, he erected two spacious galleries for the reception of paintings and curiosities of which he was an indefatigable collector but having gone beyond his means the lands of Grangecon have within the last few months been sold to De Mahony Esqre. Knockrigg an excellent new house is occupied by its Proprietor James Wall Esqre. To the North East of Grangecon Ho. and very close to the garden wall is the ruin of Grangecon Castle of which some small portion of the side walls are still to be seen. In the garden of Grangecon is the stone which was over the door of the old Castle and bears the attached inscription. The stone is about 7 inches thick 1 foot  $3\frac{1}{2}$  inches broad and the same in length. Mr. Wall of Knockrigg has a curious old stone which he considers was the head stone of one of the O'Tooles. Raised writing on two sides and on a third Free Masons Hieroglyphics.

There is a very ancient grave yard in Knockrigg called Kill Mc Ough. It is the burial place of the Wall family; the only tombstone in it is that of the late James Wall Esqre. of Knockrigg who died in 1791. The road from Baltinglass to Ballytore passes through part of the West side of the Parish. County Cess laid on for the Psh. at Summer Assizes 1837, was £275. 17s. 9d.
