Harrington Escro. till lately resided here, he erected two spacious aslleries for the reception of paintings and curiosities of which he was an indefatigable collector but having gone beyond his means the lands of Grangecon have within the last few months been sold to De Mohony Esqre. Knockrigg an excellent new house is occupied by its Proprietor James Wall Esgre. To the North East of Grangecon Ho. and very close to the garden wall is the ruin of Grangecon Castle of which some small portion of the side walls are still to be seen. In the garden of Grangecon is the stone which was over the door of the old Castle and

of the old Castle and bears the attached inscription. The stone is about 7 inches thick I foot of inches broad and the same in length. Mr. Wall of Enockriss has a curious old stone which he considers was the head stone of one of the o'Tooles. Raised writing on two sides and on a third Free Masons Rieroslyphics.

GODSSTR ENGTHIS MY DEFE CE 1625

There is a very ancient grave yard in Enockrigg called Kill Mc Ough. It is the burial place of the Wall family; the only tombstone in it is that of the late James Wall Esqre. of Enockrigg who died in 1791. The road from Baltinglass to Ballytore passes through part of the West side of the Parish. Gounty Cess laid on for the Psh. at Summer Assises 1837, was £275. 17s. 9d.
