MUZZLING OF DOGS.

2. Any dog found in or on any public place within the said Poor Law Union, not being muzzled as required in Regulation 1, shall be seized and detained; and, in addition to any penalty to which the owner of such dog may be liable for the breach of Regulation No. 1, all expenses connected with such detention may be recovered from the owner of such dog in a Court of Summary Jurisdiction; and, further, if such dog is not claimed within three days from the date of the seizure thereof, it shall be killed or otherwise disposed of as may be directed by the Local Authority, or by an Inspector or Officer authorized by the Local Authority in that behalf.

3. These Regulations shall continue in force until altered or revoked.

PENALTIES.

The Diseases of Animals Act, 1894, provides that contravention of a Regulation of a Local Authority thereunder is an offence against the Act, which renders the offender liable to a penalty not exceeding £20 for every such offence.

REGULATIONS FOR RABIES.

SIR,

I am directed by the Lord Lieutenant to request that you will be so good as to acquaint your Local Authority that His Excellency is advised that in making regulations directing the muzzling of dogs on account of Rabies, it would be desirable for the Local Authority to insist on the muzzling of all dogs (other than dogs while being used for sporting purposes, or for the capture and destruction of vermin, and in charge of competent persons,) whilst being in any public place, whether the dogs are led or not, with a muzzle so constructed as to render it impossible for the dog while wearing the same to bite any person or animal. Any alternative regulation which permits a leading strap or chain to be substituted for the muzzle does not afford sufficient security, it being elear that a led dog (if he is unmuzzled) is able to bite any person or animal that may happen to pass within his reach; and this objection applies even more strongly to an alternative regulation which permits dogs to be in a public place under what is called control.

It would probably be useful if at the foot of hand bills or notices announcing regulations, the following short description of the most marked symptoms of Rabies were given:—
