CHIEF EXECUTIVE'S ORDER NO. CA/610/15

SECTION 49 OF THE PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT ACT 2000 (AS AMENDED)

SUPPLEMENTARY DEVELOPMENT CONTRIBUTION SCHEME

WICKLOW PORT ACCESS AND TOWN RELIEF ROAD

The Supplementary Development Contribution Scheme for the construction of the Wicklow Port Access and Town Relief Road was adopted by the members of Wicklow County Council on 14th November 2005 for a duration of 10 years. The scheme provides that this period shall remain in effect unless and until "some other period of time shall be substituted for that period by order of the Wicklow County Council".


Having regard to the reduced level of development and resultant reduction in income since the adoption of the scheme, the outstanding balance (including loans) of circa €27.5m at 30th June 2015, together with commitments of circa €2m, it is necessary to extend the duration of the scheme and it is recommended that a period of 20 years from 14th November 2005 be substituted for the original 10 year period.

It is noted that the scheme provides that "the level of contributions received will be monitored on a regular basis and if the anticipated contribution generated by the scheme is realised earlier than 10 years (20 now recommended), then proposals in this regard will be submitted to the elected members of Wicklow County Council".

ORDER:

Period of duration of 20 years with effect from 14th November 2005 for the Supplementary Development Contribution Scheme in respect of the Wicklow Port Access and Town Relief Road be substituted for the 10 year period contained in the scheme. The level of contributions and outstanding balances to be monitored for the said 20 year period.
