Location: R755 Kilmacanogue, section within the 50kph speed limit.


██████████ wish to suggest some improvements to improve safety for all road users, particularly young children walking to the nearby primary school:

- The 50kph limit is not adhered to by the majority of drivers. I would suggest initially undertaking speed surveys along the section of road posted as 50kph, and then implementing speed control measures (speed ramps, if needed).

- Recent improvements to the footpath on the north side of the R755 are very welcomed, and it would be great to see similar works on the south side; to narrow the trafficked carriageway (which would help control speeds); and to help residents on both sides of the R755 walk safely to the nearby amenities.

- Public lighting is poor along this section; with large sections unlit, or poorly lit. In the few months we've been here the lighting at the R755 roundabout (the 2nd roundabout to the west of the N11) has been out of operation. A review should be undertaken along the section from the N11 to west of the Rocky Valley Drive junction.
