Submission

A suggestion to make Monastery road one way from the cul de sac on it down as far as the village and to include a wider pedestrian path and two way cycle path. Enniskerry is increasingly busy. Monastery road has some extremely narrow points and sharp bends while narrow and is regularly used by cyclists, pedestrians, cars and larger trucks/vans etc. There have been many accidents (a car flipped last week on a bend, this is not the first time I have heard of that happening)and I predict there will be many more if this is not changed.
