Further down this lane there are many homes all lying within this agricultural area, making it similar to a residential area.




Under article HD23 point nine which states "the son or daughter of a landowner who has inherited a site for the purpose of building a one-off rural house and where the land has been in family ownership as at 11th October 2004 for at least 10 years prior to the application for planning permission and not as speculation". I should have been eligible to get planning permission based on this, as this land has been in my family for generations, I was however told I would be refused. After seeking help from my local elected representatives who were as shocked as I was with this refusal, their advice was to apply to rezone the site and have it included within the revised boundaries of the Local Area Plan for Kilcoole.




OSI DIGITAL PLACE MAP
