Catholick; their general occupation agriculture; most of the houses have a very uncomfortable appearance; the road from Dunleavin, to Ballymore Eustace, and Hollywood, 2 passes through the N.W. side of the Ph., also the road from Dunleavin to Kilcullen and Neas passes through the West corner; on the East side of Tubber Demesne is a grave yard, in the North corner of which is the ruins of a Church only portions of the foundation remain; the Parish is of a triangular form, the South side is about half a mile from the Town of Dunleavin being the Nearest Market Town, Market day Thursday.

In the County of Wicklow, Barony of Lower Talbotstown and Parish of Tubber. Bounded on the North by the Ph. of Ballybought; on the East by the Ph. of Crehelf; on the South by the Townland of Sandyhills and on the W. by the Demesne of Tubber and Giltown Ph. in Co. Kildare.

Contains 165 acres 1 road 20 pers. the property of Mr. Leslie of Glasslough, Co. Monaghan. Agent Mr. Murdough Mt. Joy Square, Dublin. It is let at about 30s. per acre. The houses are mostly mud (there is from 2 to 3 feet stone) having a very uncomfortable appearance; the inhabitants are all Catholick; occupation agriculture; the soil is 4 mixed with gravel, produces good crops; the road from Dunleavin to Hollywood skirts the South Boundary of the Tld. and the road from Dunleavin to Ballymore Eustace the West Boundary; it is situated about two miles from the Town of Dunleavin, and three from Ballymore Eustace; public Cess 2/- per acre.

Joy Square, Dublin; it is let at £2. per acre; the houses are all stone having a pretty comfortable appearance; at the Cross roads of Tubber is a Police Station on the East side of Townland; half a mile S.W. of which is Tubber 6 house and is in a ruinous state; East of Tubber house is an artificial mound embankment & fish pond, about two chains South is the grave yard of Tubber in the North side of the ruins of a Church; the road from Dunlavin to Ballymore Eastice skirts the S.W. Boundary of the Townland; Cess 2/- per acre.
