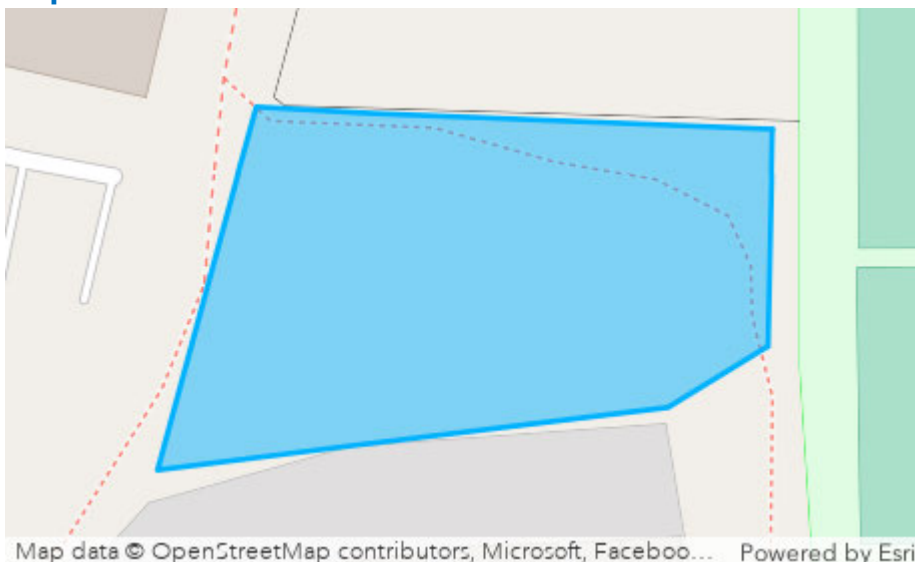
Submission

I suggest following through on the proposal submitted a few years ago by Clr Mags Crean, to create a mini forest and walkway on the land between Burnaby Avenue and Aldi/Council Depot in Greystones. This would help with drainage, contribute to biodiversity, create natural habitats and help to absorb carbon emissions.

If designed well (ie including trees stumps for seating, and pollinators) this could prove to be a safe nature trail for neighbouring pre-schools, creches and junior schools.

The installation of a kissing fence, or similar, would stop the dumping of green waste in this area.
