The Houses harring having particular names are Fort Fortner House in Ballymaurice Upper Townland; Croneasallagh House in Cronessallagh Townland; Ballard Park in Ballium Townland: Ballinaclash Cottage in Ballinaclash Townland: Abbey View in Bahana Whaley Townland & Ballymoney House in Ballymoney Townland. There is a R. C. Chapel in the village of Macreddin, a School in the village of Sheanamore and a police station in the village of Aughrim. The anitquities are the ruins of an abbey, Lady Well, 3 Forts in Cleneskin Townland, one in Ballyshane Townland, one in Hallymaurice Upper Townland and a Rahean in Cronebeg Townland.
